CHECK LIST

• All horses/ponies except those competing only in the Opportunity/ Outreach must have a recorded microchip

• All horses/ponies on grounds must have a health certificate within 30 (watch CSC Facebook, Instagram, and coloradoshowcircuit.com as this may be changed to a 10 day should there be any health concerns in the area)

• Must also have vaccination record with vaccines given within the last 180 days but no more recent than the previous 7 days

• Must have proof of negative coggins

• All trainers, riders, and OWNERS OF RECORD must be active members or pay the show pass fee and MUST have completed SafeSport training. We will not be allowed to let you participate if this has not been completed prior to the start of showing. These must be done online prior to the show. WE CAN NO LONGER PROCESS MEMBERSHIPS OR SHOW PASSES ON SITE, PER USEF/USHJA. Horses/Riders who have not solved ineligibility by the start of competition will still be liable for stall fee, ordered shavings, and \$150.

• Horses must have a USEF Recording number or USHJA Registration number, this number must be active for points to count

• Horses in the Junior Hunters must have a measurement card. If they do not, please notify the office by 3:00 Monday afternoon so that we may schedule an official measurement with the steward and vet prior to the start of classes.

• Juniors who have aged out, make sure that when you renew your membership that you choose Amateur or Pro as you must have an Amateur card to compete in the Adult Amateurs or Amateur Owners.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, Senior Active and Junior Active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrilled classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Colorado. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation, and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or. The Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product that they may not be used in such as way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATION

All horses competing in federation non-breed restricted competitions must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms. Applications for Registration Numbers can be completed online or using the Horse Registration application form. See HU101.1 and JP100.2 of the USEF Rule Book. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license to operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

ENTRIES

Competitors are encouraged to enter using Horseshowing.com (see Upcoming Shows— CSC) or submit email their entries to coloradoshowcircuit@gmail.com. Scanned PDFs preferred but photographs will be accepted. Mail to: Colorado Show Circuit 7686 Nuthatch Way, Parker CO 80134. Entry blanks will be accepted ONLY when signed by the owner or exhibitor's agent, trainer, and rider. Be sure to include the USEF Membership number of your trainer, rider and owner on the entry form. No numbers will be released until proper credentials and all signatures are in order. For late fees see page 25.

Per USEF, BACK NUMBERS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES THAT A HORSE IS OUT OF ITS STALL.

All exhibitors in Amateur sections must present their Amateur certification at the office before numbers will be released. Non member fees will be \$45 each to both USEF and USHJA.

MEASUREMENTS

All exhibitors in the Junior Hunter sections must present their measurement cards at the office before numbers will be released. All Juniors Hunters who do not possess a current measurement card will be measured with the steward by appointment. If a measurement is needed, please notify the horse show by emailing <u>ColoradoShowCircuit@gmail.com</u> by Monday, March 10th so that arrangements may be made with the vet.

MANAGEMENT

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with GR914. Colorado Show Circuit, the owner, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show.

THIS WILL BE A CONDTIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS

+ A processing fee of \$50 plus collection fees will be made for any non-negotiable checks

+ Venmo, checks, PayPal, or Credit Cards are all approved methods of payment

+ All riders must wear ASTM Certified protective headgear while mounted

- + No alterations are to be made to permanent stabling or other facilities by exhibitors
- + No smoking is permitted inside the barn
- + Prize money exceeding entry fees will be distributed within 30 days

+ Dogs must be leashed at all times. Per USEF Rule 1301.6 dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance for warning cards.

+ Schooling will be available from 10:00 – 5:00 on Thursday with Hacking Only available 6:30 – 7:30 Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be given, for all but stall fees, in the case of a vet note or if a barn brings an alternate horse/rider combination as a substitution or if the stall can be resold. Once a horse/rider has arrived on property refunds for grounds/stall/office/and medic will not be given. Stall fees are non-refundable after booking unless an alternate horse is used.

PRIZE MONEY DISTRIBUTION

Prize money in all the hunter and regular jumper classes unless otherwise specified will be distributed 30%, 22%, 15%, 12%, 11%, 10%. Competition #344792 is offering \$4,425 in rated money (\$750 guaranteed). For full division prize money at least 6 entries may be required to compete.

FEES

Any class without a listed fee is \$40

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness. A Champion and Reserve Champion ribbon will be given in each Hunter section that includes an under saddle class. Three classes with at least 3 completions must be held in order to award champions. Championships will be broken by highest over fences points. Jumper ties other than first will be broken by time taken in the first round. Ties in a speed round will stand.

ARENA DIMENSIONS

Indoor Competition Arena is 120X180. Additional Schooling: 90x240. Arena is a dirt/sand blend in competition arena, as well as the warm up arena.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

All USEF Life and Senior Active member, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. Tickets equal to USEF Points will be given out in classes that do not give prize money. Tickets may be given to another person, turned in for prizes, or saved and combined with past and future CSC competitions for bigger prizes such as custom coolers (your colors and logo), custom tack trunks.

Lunging will be available in the side arena from 6:00 - 8:00. This arena may be used for lunging additionally if there are no horses hacking. Preference will be given to hacking horses.

Schooling will be available from 10:00 – 5:00 on Thursday and Hacking from 6:30 – 7:30 Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. End of day schooling will not be available Friday or Saturday.

Warm Ups: Please enter your classes early, if the trip count is going to run the day too long, warm ups will be removed from the schedule.

Champion and Reserve: will be awarded in divisions with 3 or more classes including an under saddle with 3 or more entries. Ties will be broken by over fences. Fences: Spreads will not exceed fence height.

The last class in each section is the Under Saddle. Classes with a * in the Hunters indicate a Handy round.

Horses may enter the Green Hunter Section in any height for which they are eligible. A horse may only enter one Green Hunter Section per competition.

Derbies will be run in a 2 round format unless entries warrant swapping to a Hunt and Go. Decision will be posted on Saturday.

To enter the Derby, horses must be entered in at least one full division of Hunter or Equitation.

6 Entries must compete in order for full prize money to be paid out in the Derbies. If horse/rider combo has competed during the weekend, they must compete in a derby that is within 3" either way of the height at which they competed together. Horse/Rider combo may only enter one derby.

Competition Fees: Each horse will be charged a USEF Fee of \$23 per competition (\$15 Drugs and Medications, \$8 USEF), a \$7 fee for USHJA Zone fees. Any non-member must purchase a \$45 show pass fee from USEF.org and a 4a30 show pass fee from USHJA.org. The only exception is riders competing only in the .75 jumpers or the Short/Long/Rusty Stirrups/Cross Rails/Walk Trot Canter. Show Passes can not be purchased from the horse show office. Show passes may only be purchased once per year.

To be eligible to participate as a trainer/coach, one must be a Senior Active Member.

Trainer Horses: Horses ridden only in open classes only by the trainer of record will have the office fee waived.

Opportunity/Outreach Horses: In addition to being exempt from certain USEF fees, horses that are participating only in Opportunity classes will have the office fee waived.

General Specifications

Back Numbers: All horses must be accompanied by a back number at all times that they are out of the stall or away from the trailer.

Jog Format: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance class in the Performance Hunter, Green Hunter, Junior Hunter, Amateur Hunter. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to trot another circle at the request of the judge.

USEF Horse Recording: Horses must be recorded with USEF annually or for life in order to be eligible for HOTY Awards and/or Zone Awards.

USHJA Horse Registration: All competing horses must have a Registration number from USHJA.

Opportunity/Outreach Classes: All opportunity/outreach classes will be held in accordance with GR821. Riders who are entered in these classes only are exempt from the Federation membership requirements and are not required to pay a non member fee but are required to list the Federation membership number is the participant is a member.

Combining, Dividing, or Canceling Divisions or Classes: All decisions to combine, divide, or cancel classes or divisions will be made in accordance with USEF/USHJA rules.

Prize Money: Prize money will credited to a show bill, in the instance that prize money exceeds the show bill, checks will be issued within 30 days of the close of competition, thereby ending the show's responsibility as long as all criteria have been met. A valid Social Security number or Federal ID number and valid address must be provided in addition to a W-9.

Food Service: Soda, Gatorade, Water, and snacks will be available for purchase at the show office beginning at 7am until the conclusion of each show day. Food trucks will be available outside the building from 11 - 2 Friday – Sunday.

Show Veterinarian and Show Farrier contact information will be posted in the barns and outside the show office. Sharps containers will be available at the end of alternating aisles.

Trainer splits: Please organize trainer splits with the office by Friday afternoon or before clients begin checking out. If a client checks out before splits have been applied, trainer will be responsible for the remaining balance.

Schooling: \$20 assessed to all Hunter and Equitation horses. This will cover any and all schooling/hacking Thursday – Saturday.


Trailer In: A trailer in fee of \$90 will be assessed to any horse that does not have a stall. **Medic:** \$25 assessed to each entry.
