EQUITATION DIVISIONS

To be judged on position, performance, control of mount and correct style.

Leadline - Open to children 7 yrs and younger. May not cross enter into any other classes. Ties for Champion or Reserve will go to the rider with the most points in the WT class. **Walk-Trot** - Open to riders who are not ready to canter at horse shows and have not shown over fences 2' or higher at any time. May cross enter only into other walk/trot classes or divisions at this show as eligible.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Riders 12 yrs and under. To show over crossrails. May not cross enter a division to jump higher than 2'.

Beginner Rider Equitation - Open to riders of any age in their first or second year of showing. To show over crossrails. Trotting anywhere on course permitted.

Junior/Amateur Equitation - Open to junior and adult amateur riders. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses.

Blue Jeans & Half Chaps Division - Open to riders of all ages who are in their first or second year of horse showing, who have not shown over fences 2' or higher at any horse show. ASTM approved riding helmets and boots are required, however formal show attire is NOT required. Riders may not cross enter into any other division at today's show.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

To be judged on performance, manners, way of going and suitability.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Riders 12 yrs and under, a simple course over crossrails. May not enter a division to jump higher than 2'.

Modified Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies ridden by junior or adult amateur riders. Fences 2'.

Low Children's Hunter Pony - Open to Junior riders on ponies. All ponies jump 2'. Pony/ Rider combination may not cross enter into the Children's Hunter divisions.

Low Children's Hunter Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6". Horse/ Rider combination may not cross enter into Children's Hunter divisions.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'6". Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Children's Hunter - Open to junior riders. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Low Children's Hunter. Horses 2'9", Large ponies 2'6", Small/Medium ponies 2'. **Adult Amateur Hunter** - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'9". Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

Developing Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing. Trotting anywhere on course permitted. To show over crossrails with groundlines.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences, who have not shown over fences 2'9" or higher. Simple changes of lead not to be penalized. Fences Section A: 2' or Section B: 2'6".

Thoroughbred Hunter - Open to any registered and non-registered thoroughbreds. Fences 2'3".

Low Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies to be ridden by juniors, adults or professionals. Fences Section A: 2'6" or Section B:2'9".

PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Judged on manners, suitability, performance and kindness.

Pleasure Horse or Pony - Open to all riders of any age or qualification on a horse or pony. Division to be a walk-trot class, a walk-trot canter class and a class of a simple course, ponies to jump 2', horses to jump 2'6", no oxers.
