## **Open Hunter Divisions**

#### PERFORMANCE HUNTER

Open to all horses. No restrictions by previous show history. Fence height 3'3" to 3'6".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **GREEN HUNTER**

This division is set at the following height options: 3'0", 3'3", 3'6", and 3'9" as defined by USEF.

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### 3'0" THOROUGHBRED HUNTER

Open to 'Thoroughbred' horses that are in possession of Breed Registry papers. Cross entry into other sections is allowed, except 2'6" Thoroughbred Hunter. Fence height 3'0"; spreads not to exceed fence height.

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **LOW HUNTER 3'**

Open to horses and ponies in any classification of showing. Fence height 3'0".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **BABY GREEN HUNTER 2'6"**

A Baby Green Hunter is a horse or pony of any age in it's first or second year of showing at 2'6", and has never competed over fences higher than 2'6".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddlele

#### **SPECIAL HUNTER 2'6"**

Open to all horses and ponies. Fence height 2'6".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### 2'6" THOROUGHBRED HUNTER

Open to 'Thoroughbred' horses that are in possession of Breed Registry papers. Cross entry into other sections is allowed, except 3'0" Thoroughbred Hunter. Fence height 3'0"; spreads not to exceed fence height.

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **OPEN HUNTER 2'3"**

Open to all horses and ponies. Fence height 2'3".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **BEGINNING HUNTER 2'**

Open to all horses and ponies. Fence height 2'0".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **VERY LOW HUNTER 2'**

Open to all horses and ponies. No oxers. Fence height 2'0".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **FUTURE HUNTER 2'**

Open to riders of any age or beginner horses or ponies that have never shown over 2'0". Fence height 1'6"-2'0".

3 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **UNRESTRICTED WALK/TROT POLES**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going.

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **UNRESTRICTED CROSSRAILS 18"**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going.

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

## **Non-Pro Hunter Divisions**

#### AMATEUR/OWNER HUNTER

Open to horses ridden by an amateur owner or an amateur member of the owner's family, 18 years of age and older. Fence height 3'3" to 3'6".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### JUNIOR HUNTER

Open to horses ridden by a junior exhibitor. Cross entry: A Junior Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in the Children's Hunter section. Fence height 3'3" to 3'6".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER 3'**

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter division may compete 1 different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division and must own or have a USEF registered lease of said horse. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. Fence height 2'9" to 3'0"; spreads not to exceed fence height. 4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **CHILDREN'S HUNTER 3'**

To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current competition year. Cross Entry: Riders entered in Children's Hunter Horse sections may not compete in any other class in which the obstacles exceed 3'5" at the same competition (exception: Equitation classes up to 3'9", Jumper classes 1.20m and lower and Junior Hunter sections). A Children's Hunter rider may only compete one different horse in the Junior Hunter Section. Horses entered in Children's Hunter classes may not cross enter into Junior Hunter sections at the same competition. Riders entered in the Children's Hunter Horse section may only compete on one Children's Hunter Pony at the same competition. Fence height 2'9" to 3'0"; spreads not to exceed fence height.

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **MODIFIED CHILD/ADULT HUNTER 2'9"**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adult riders who are considered amateurs according to USEF rules or junior riders according to USEF rules. Fence height 2'9".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **LOW ADULT HUNTER 2'6"**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by adult riders who are considered amateurs according to USEF rules. Cross Entry: Rider may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where the fences exceed 3'0". Fence height 2'6".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER 2'6"**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders according to USEF rules. Cross Entry: Riders may not cross-enter at the same show into the Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter or any class/section where fences exceed 3'0". Fence height 2'6".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### N.E.S.T. NON-PRO HUNTER 2'3"

Open to all horses and ponies ridden by junior or amateur riders. Includes oxers. Fence height 2'3".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### CHILDREN'S PONY HUNTER 2' or 2'6"

Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. Ponies may not compete in the Children's section if also entered in the pony division at the same show. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability as a Children's Hunter Pony. Ponies need not be jogged for soundness. No in and outs. To be offered at two heights: fences 2' for small and medium and 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed fence height.

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **LIMIT HUNTER 2'**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by exhibitors 12 years of age and over. Limited to riders who have never shown over fences 2'6" or higher or in any pony hunter/jumper division. Fence height 1'6" to 2'3".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

#### **SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER 2'**

Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior exhibitors 11 years of age and under. Limited to riders who have never shown over fences 2'6" or higher or in any pony hunter/jumper division. Fence height 1'6" to 2'3".

4 Over Fences and 1 Under Saddle

## **Equitation Divisions**

#### **CHILDREN'S EQUITATION 3'**

Open to riders eligible for the Children's Hunter division. May not cross enter into any divisions with fences higher than 3'3". Fence height 3'0".

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### **ADULT EQUITATION 3'-3'6"**

Open to adults 18 years of age and over. Can be combined with 15-17 Equitation if entries warrant. Fences height 3'0" or 3'6".

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### 15-17 EQUITATION 3'-3'6"

Open to riders age 15 to 17. Fence height 3'0" to 3'6".

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### 12-14 EQUITATION 2'6"-3'0"

Open to riders age 12 to 14. Fence height 2'6" or 3'0". Exception: ponies may jump their respective fence height.

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### 11 AND UNDER EQUITATION 2'0"-2'6"

Open to riders 11 years old and under. Fence height 2'0" to 2'6", no combinations. Exception: ponies may jump their respective fence height.

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### **LOW ADULT EQUITATION 2'6"**

Open to riders eligible for the Low Adult Hunter division. Riders in this division may not cross enter into any other age group equitation division. Fence height 2'6". Cannot be combined with any other age group equitation.

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### LOW CHILDREN'S EQUITATION 2'6"

Open to riders eligible for the Low Children's Hunter division. Riders in this division may only cross enter into any other age group equitation division that does not require them to jump 2'6" or higher. Fence height 2'6". Cannot be combined with any other age group equitation.

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### N.E.S.T. NON-PRO EQUITATION 2'3"

Open to riders eligible for the N.E.S.T. Non-Pro Hunter 2'3" division. Includes oxers. Fence height 2'3".

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### **LIMIT EQUITATION 2'**

Open to riders eligible for the Limit Hunter division. Fence height 1'6" to 2'3", no combinations.

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION 2'

Open to riders eligible for the Short Stirrup Hunter division. Riders may cross-enter into the 11 and Under Equitation classes if it does not require them to jump 2'6" or higher. Fence height 1'6" to 2'3", no combinations.

2 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### **CROSSRAILS EQUITATION 18"**

Open to riders of any age who have not shown at a canter over a course of fences higher than 18". Trotting is not penalized. Cantering is permitted on the flat in small groups (five or less) only. Showing in this division does not affect a rider's eligibility for Walk/Trot Equitation. Riders may cross enter into future hunters at the same show providing the fence height does not exceed 18".

4 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### WALK/TROT CROSSRAILS EQUITATION

Open to riders of any age. Emphasis will be placed on suitability of mount to rider's ability level and demonstrating control of mount is extremely important. Safety will be the foremost concern in these classes. Cantering/excessive speed will be penalized.

4 Over Fences and 1 Flat

#### **WALK/TROT POLES EQUITATION**

Open to riders of any age who have never shown over fences or in a class requiring them to canter (except Crossrail Equitation). Ground pole trotting is permitted.

4 Over Fences and 1 Flat

## **Medal Classes**

#### 3' KHJA/OHJA/NEST MEDAL

Jumping phase, followed by flat phase judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse. Each phase of the class (over fences and on the flat) shall count fifty (50) percent toward placings. Fence height 3'0".

#### 2'6" KHJA/OHJA/NEST MEDAL

Jumping phase, followed by flat phase judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse. Each phase of the class (over fences and on the flat) shall count fifty (50) percent toward placings. Fence height 2'6".

#### 2' KHJA/OHJA/NEST MEDAL

Jumping phase, followed by flat phase judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse. Each phase of the class (over fences and on the flat) shall count fifty (50) percent toward placings. Fence height 2'.

## **Open Jumper Divisions**

#### SCHOOLING/TRAINING JUMPER .75m-1.20m

Open to horses and ponies. If a high and low section is offered for this division at the same show an individual horse or pony may only compete in one of the sections. Offered at fence heights 0.75m, .85m, .90m, 1.00m and 1.10m.

4 Over Fences

#### **DEBUT JUMPER .70m**

Open to all horses and ponies ridden by riders of all ages and any experience. Fence height 0.70m.

4 Over Fences

## **Non-Pro Jumper Divisions**

#### JUNIOR/AMATEUR OWNER JUMPER 1.20m

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or amateur owner rider. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Childrens or Adult Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into Children or Adult Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. If a high and low section is offered for this division at the same show, an individual horse may only compete in one of the sections. Fence height 1.20m.

4 Over Fences

#### HIGH CHILD/ADULT JUMPER 1.10m-1.15m

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or amateur rider. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Junior or Amateur Owner Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into Low Junior, Low Amateur Owner or Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above 1.30m (4'3") in any open class at the same show. If a high and low section is offered for this division at the same show, an individual horse or pony may only compete in one of the sections. Fence height 1.10m to 1.15m.

4 Over Fences

#### LOW CHILD/ADULT JUMPER 1.00-1.05m

Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior or amateur rider. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Junior or Amateur Owner Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into Low Junior, Low Amateur Owner or Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above 1.30m (4'3") in any open class at the same show. If a high and low section is offered for this division at the same show, an individual horse or pony may only compete in one of the sections. Fence height 1.00m to 1.05m.

4 Over Fences

#### NOVICE CHILD/ADULT JUMPER .90m-.95m

Open to horses and riders who qualify for the child and adult jumper divisions. Fence height 0.90m to 0.95m.

4 Over Fences

#### MODIFIED CHILD/ADULT JUMPER .85m

Open to horses and riders who qualify for the child and adult jumper divisions. Fence height 0.85m.

4 Over Fences

## **Non-Pro Jumper Divisions**

## INTERMEDIATE CHILD/ADULT JUMPER .75m-.80m

To be ridden by an intermediate junior or adult rider, as defined by the intermediate children's and adult hunter division. Cross-entering into the Child/Adult Jumper division on any horse at the same show is not allowed. Fence height 0.75m to 0.85m.

## THOROUGHBRED ENGLISH PLEASURE WALK/

To be run with the Unrestricted Walk/Trot Groundpoles Under Saddle class. The class will be split if entries warrant. Entries must be completed Friday by end of show for class to be split. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided.

## THOROUGHBRED ENGLISH PLEASURE WALK/ TROT/CANTER

To be run with the Unrestricted Crossrails Under Saddle class. The class will be split if entries warrant. Entries must be completed Friday by end of show for class to be split. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided.

#### HIGH POINT THOROUGHBRED HUNTER AWARD

Awarded to the Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points in Hunter classes. High point ribbon provided.

#### THOROUGHBRED CROSSRAILS

To be run with Unrestricted Crossrails division. The class will be split if entries warrant. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### **VERY GREEN THOROUGHBRED HUNTER**

To be run with N.E.S.T. Beginning Hunter division. The class will be split if entries warrant. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### BEGINNING THOROUGHBRED HUNTER (2'3" TIP)

To be run with N.E.S.T. Open Hunter 2'3" division. The class will be split if entries warrant. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### SPECIAL THOROUGHBRED HUNTER (2'6" TIP)

To be run with 2'6" Thoroughbred Hunter division. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### LOW THOROUGHBRED HUNTER DIVISION (3'TIP)

To be run with 3'0" Thoroughbred Hunter division. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### THOROUGHBRED HOPEFUL JUMPER I (2'6")

To be run with Schooling/Training 2'6" and/or Intermediate Child/Adult Jumper. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### THOROUGHBRED SUITABLE JUMPER II (2'9")

To be run with Schooling/Training 2'9" and/or Modified Child/Adult Jumper. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### THOROUGHBRED SCHOOLING JUMPER III (3'0")

To be run with Schooling/Training 3'0" and/or Novice Child/ Adult Jumper. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/ reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### **THOROUGHBRED TRAINING JUMPER (3'3")**

To be run with Schooling/Training 3'3" and/or Low Child/ Adult Jumper. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/ reserve ribbons (if applicable).

#### THOROUGHBRED OPEN JUMPER (3'6")

To be run with Schooling/Training 3'6" and/or High Child/ Adult Jumper. Ribbons for 1st to 6th provided and champion/ reserve ribbons (if applicable).

## **Additional Classes**

#### YEARLING HUNTER BREEDING

Open to horses and ponies 1 year of age. To be judged on conformation, quality, substance and suitability to become a hunter

#### TWO-YEAR-OLD HUNTER BREEDING

Open to horses and ponies 2 years of age. To be judged on conformation, quality, substance and suitability to become a hunter.

#### THREE-YEAR-OLD HUNTER BREEDING

Open to horses and ponies 3 years of age. To be judged on conformation, quality, substance and suitability to become a hunter.

#### FOUR- TO SIX-YEAR-OLD HUNTER BREEDING

Open to horses and ponies 4-6 years of age. To be judged on conformation, quality, substance and suitability to become a hunter.

#### **BEST YOUNG HORSE**

The top two placings from each hunter breeding class are invited to show in the Hunter Breeding Championship class to determine division Champion and Reserve Champion.

#### **LEADLINE**

Open to riders age 1-7, mounted on horses or ponies and led by a chaperone. Judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. No Schooling, Office or EMT/Assoc. Fees for leadline.

## **Ride for Wine Adult Medal**

Open to adult amateur riders age 21 and over. First round to be an equitation style course, judged on position, track and consistency. All riders return for a test, to be determined by the judge (may be jumping, or combination of jumping and flat exercises). Rider's choice of fence height: 2', 2'6" or 3'.

## Ride for Fido Children's Medal

#### RIDE FOR A WORTHY CAUSE!

Hosted at NEST II: June 6-8, 2025 • Fee: \$40 Open to junior exhibitors only. First round to be an equitation style course, judged on position, track and consistency. All riders return for a test, to be determined by the judge (may be jumping, or combination of jumping and flat exercises). Rider's choice of fence height: 2', 2'6" or 3'.

## **N.E.S.T.** Pairs Classic

#### SYNC UP WITH YOUR BFF!

Hosted at NEST III: July 25-27, 2025 • Fee: \$40 Open to junior and amateur exhibitors only. Pairs of two enter the ring together, one leading and the other following, switching places at a point in the course of their choosing. Final jump to be jumped in tandem. Pair's choice of fence height: 2', 2'6" or 3'.

## N.E.S.T. Hunter Derby

#### ALL ENTRANTS RIDE THE HANDY ROUND!

Hosted at NEST IV: August 15-17, 2025 • Fee: \$40 Open to junior and amateur exhibitors only. First round is a classic hunter round, followed by a second handy round. The score from Round 1 will be added to the score from Round 2 to determine the overall, final score and placings. Rider's choice of fence height: 2', 2'6" or 3'.

## **N.E.S.T. Pony Finals Prep Derby**

#### **GET READY FOR PONY FINALS!**

Hosted at NEST IV: August 15-17, 2025 • Fee: \$40 Open to junior exhibitors riding ponies only. First round is a classic hunter round, followed by a second handy round. The score from Round 1 will be added to the score from Round 2 to determine the overall, final score and placings. Small Ponies: 2'3", Medium: 2'6" or Large: 2'9".

# Rules and Regulations

#### Horse Show Management

The Horse Show Management reserves the right in itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interest of the show and its exhibitors. Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors and employees, contractors, sponsoring entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform. It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience.

#### Health Requirements

Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. All horses must have valid proof of negative coggins test (within 12 months). A 30 day certificate of veterinary inspection is required for all horses arriving from outside the state of Ohio. THIS WILL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THIS SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

#### Closing Dates

#### **Bulk Stalls and Shavings**

Stalls must be reserved via text to Nancy Arledge at (614) 989-5717.

Bulk stall reservations for trainers/farms are appreciated a minimum of two (2) weeks in advance of the show date. All bulk stall and shaving reservations are finalized by Monday of the show week and are not refundable.

If you reserve a stall and for any reason do not attend the show, YOU WILL BE CHARGED a stall fee unless you contact Nancy Arledge at (614) 989-5717 or the show office prior to the start of the show Wednesday morning.

#### **Entries**

Entries must be created online at horsespot.net by midnight on Wednesday of the show week to avoid late fees. Any entries made after this time are subject to a \$50 late fee. Please note, you may add and/or scratch at the show per the adding and scratching rules below. Mailed entries are not accepted at this time.

#### Adding Classes

Same day adds are permitted for individual classes including warm-ups, however any divisions entered on the same day will be subject to a \$25 late fee. Warm-up adds may be done at the ring, but individual class adds/divisions must be done in the office prior to the start of the class/ division.

#### Scratching Classes

This MUST BE DONE IN THE SHOW OFFICE. Full credit will be given for any classes scratched before the start of the class. Informing the starter that you do not intend to participate does not get you scratched in the office and will not qualify for a refund.

#### Non-Showing Horses

Any horse not competing in a class or division at the show will be charged a non-showing fee of \$75 per show.

#### Schooling

Schooling in the show rings will be available weather permitting on Thursday after 12pm, as well as on show days until 30 minutes PRIOR to the start of each ring and after the show ends in each ring. Jumping in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times.

Designated schooling rings will have warm up jumps provided. Schooling rings will be closed before dawn and

after dusk each day. Each horse at the show will be charged a \$25 schooling fee.

#### **Awards**

Ribbons will be presented through 6th place.

#### Check Out, Payment and Refunds

All entries must be paid in full prior to the horse and rider leaving. Statements may be viewed online at horsespot.net to verify accuracy.

#### **Trainer Splits**

Trainers are responsible for turning in trainer splits to the show office PRIOR to any clients checking out. If trainer splits are not completed, tack stalls, shavings and hay will be split evenly among the number of stalls ordered.

#### **Payment**

For your convenience, you may leave an open credit card or check on file with the office and you will be emailed a receipt on Sunday after the completion of the show.

Acceptable payment methods are check, cash, Venmo and credit card. Credit cards will be charged a 3.5% convenience fee. Returned checks are subject to a \$50 NSF fee and \$25 admin fee. Any fees not paid at the show result in a late fee of \$50 per entry.

#### Office Hours

The office will open one (1) hour prior to the start of the show each day and close after the show has concluded.

#### Stabling

10' X 12' permanent stalls with stall doors, the floors are screenings with rubber mats. All stalls (for horses or tack) are \$150.00/each. Stalls will be reserved first come first served. Initial bedding will not be provided.

Stalls will be made available for set-up on Wednesday after 3pm, the week of the show. Horses may enter stalls no earlier than Thursday morning the week of the show.

If show management finds any trainer, competitor or groom staging a horse in a stall, a stall fee will be added to your statement. If any trainer, competitor or groom is found storing items in a stall, a stall fee will be added to your statement.

#### Haul-Ins

A \$75.00 Haul-In fee will be charged for all competitors showing out of their trailer. All horses must have either a

stall fee or haul-in fee. Exhibitors must check in at the show office before schooling/showing. All horses not stabled on show grounds will be charged a haul-in fee.

HORSES MUST BE SUPERVISED AT TRAILERS AT ALL TIMES! If a horse is found unsupervised, horse show management reserves the right to move your horse into a stall and a stall fee will be added to your statement.

#### Feed and Bedding

Bedding available for \$13 per bag, pre-reserved. No straw allowed. Hay is available, please inquire with the show office or show management for price.

#### Condition of Entry

Exhibitors are responsible for knowledge of the Rules and Regulations governing the Horse Show and for their own errors and omissions. In the case of a violation of a cross entry restriction, the exhibitor will forfeit the entry fee and class placing.

#### Rings

All of the Brave Horse Show Park's five, state-of-the-art arenas are dressed with Footing First's scientifically tested proprietary blend of SRS footing. Grand Prix Ring 340 x 240, Hunter Ring I 250 x 150, Hunter Ring II 250 x 150, Annex Ring 240 x 150.

#### Motorized Vehicles

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or quardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of

harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

#### Dogs

Well behaved dogs are welcome. All dogs must be leashed/ under control/supervised at all times. Please be kind to others stabling/camping near you -- if your dog can't wait quietly for you to return, please do not bring them to the show, so that management doesn't have to ask you to take your dog home. Individuals may not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behavior.

#### Medical Waste

In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous

medical waste container will be provided in the stable area. Failure to use them will result in a \$100 fine per needle found. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of medical waste. PLEASE DO NOT MIX NEEDLES WITH THE MANURE OR TRASH!

#### Protective Headgear

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR ASTM APPROVED HEADGEAR AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED. It is required when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

#### Poling

Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited at all times while on the show grounds. Exhibitors found in violation will forfeit all entry fees for that showing day or day afterwards.
