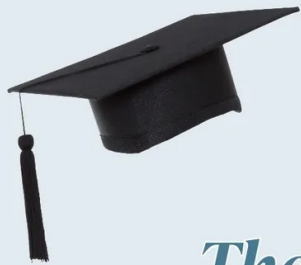

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RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Pre-entries will be accepted until 48 hours before the show. Entries received after this time will be accepted and charged a \$35 post entry fee.
2. Numbers: No numbers will be given out without full payment of all fees being secured, all required signatures, valid phone number, and all other required information on the entry form must be completed in full.

FEES

3. All exhibitors showing will be charged a \$50 EMT fee, a \$70 office fee, and \$5 USHJA & Outreach fee per horse
4. Class fees shall be \$55 for all M&S Classes and Classics, \$40/Hunter/Jumper, and Warm Up Classes unless otherwise specified.

PAYMENT

5. All entries not paid at the horse show will be considered late and will incur a \$50 late payment fee.
6. A \$100 fee will be charged for any non-negotiable funds, from checks or credit cards (Debit cards not accepted). A 4% credit card convenience fee will be added to the amount due.
7. Refunds: Entries cancelled prior to the closing date of entries will be refunded in full. Stalls and processing fees are not refundable.
8. All scratches must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund. Horses scratched the day of the show will be subject to a \$25 scratch fee. If the show must be stopped due to storm, accident, or other emergency, show management has the right to deny a refund of any fees.
9. All riders must always wear proper attire and safety Certified ASTM protective head gear while mounted.
10. Schooling will be permitted only in designated areas provided by the committee and scheduled as time permits. Back numbers must be issued and worn.
11. A jump order will be established at the in-gate with the starter.
12. All pets must always be kept on a leash.
13. Sharps containers will be located in the secretary stand.
14. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current: USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
15. Classes will be run in accordance with all leagues/organizations governing each class as listed in the class title.
16. Combined divisions may be split if entries warrant, subject to show management.
17. Stalls, if available, will be 10'x 10' temporary stalls with doors and a dirt floor. DRY STALL, Weekend Show special (Fri-Sun) \$200, or \$150 per day. Stabling fees subject to Florida sales tax. Please contact: entry@ridgeshowjumping.com prior to arrival to make arrangements. You will be required to bring your own hay grain shavings and water buckets. You will be required to clean stall daily and strip stall before you leave. A \$100.00 fee will be assessed for any stall not cleaned or stripped completely.

18. A current negative Coggins and proof of EHV vaccine will be required for all horses entering the show grounds.

19. All Marshall & Sterling designated classes will be run in accordance with M&S specifications and regulations.

20. All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners.

21. All T.I.P. Classes will be run in accordance to T.I.P specifications and regulations.. Please notify the office if you have a horse to be TIP judged (horses must be TIP registered).

Prize Money

22. Prize money will be applied to the show account balance first. In order for the prize money to be awarded, Prize money payee information must be provided, including name, address, and taxpayer identification number. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank. Each season a new W-9(for the current season) must be filled out and on file with the show office.

23. If additional Prize Money is left, it will be issued and will be mailed within 30 days using the information provided. A completed W9 is required to be on file with show management (for each current season). It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on all entry blanks Incomplete or missing information will result in money not being issued.” All Prize Money checks are Non-negotiable after 60 days from the date of issue.

Management

24. The Committee/Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, change, move, or add classes or substitute classes or schooling as deemed necessary and at their full discretion. Management has ultimate say in all disputes.

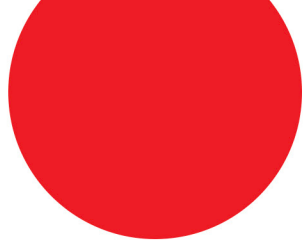

The Ridge Farm LLC, The Ridge South LLC, its employees or owners, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio, or any member of the show committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft, or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor to hold the same blameless for any accident or loss.

27. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations are read, understood, and accepted.

28. Back numbers will be issued for each horse for season. Each show requires an entry, and entries signed before competing. Anyone failing to enter correctly will be charged a \$75 fee. No exceptions.

Every effort has been made to avoid errors in this publication. The Ridge South LLC, the Grand Prix Tour Group LLC, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio or any member of the show committee assume no liability for errors. Any changes will be disclosed to the competitors upon entry. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to show management whose decision shall be final.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management is their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segway, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

EQUINE ZERO LIABILITY FLORIDA SENATE BILL 1658

EQUINE ZERO LIABILITY STATUE:

Warning - Under Florida Law an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities. In all classes wherein the rules of USEF do not apply, Management shall settle any dispute or question that may arise and its decision shall be final. Exhibitors and other participants herein, as a condition to admission, consent to such method of settlement. MANAGEMENT reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally and to cancel any entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel awards of prizes, without claim for damages. MANAGEMENT reserves the right to reschedule, combine, close, delete, or add any classes or change the listed officials as may be necessary and in the best interests of the show. Neither the show committee/staff, the show, THE RIDGE SOUTH, LLC, GRAND PRIX TOUR GROUP, LLC (d/b/a) "THE RIDGE AT WELLINGTON GROVES", and any affiliated entities), the show manager, the show sponsors, any show officials, nor any sanctioning body will be responsible for any accident, damage, loss or injury to mount, owner, rider or other persons or property Management reserves the right to modify any policy or rules set forth in the prize list in an emergency situation which may require modification or restrictions for the welfare of the horse or rider.

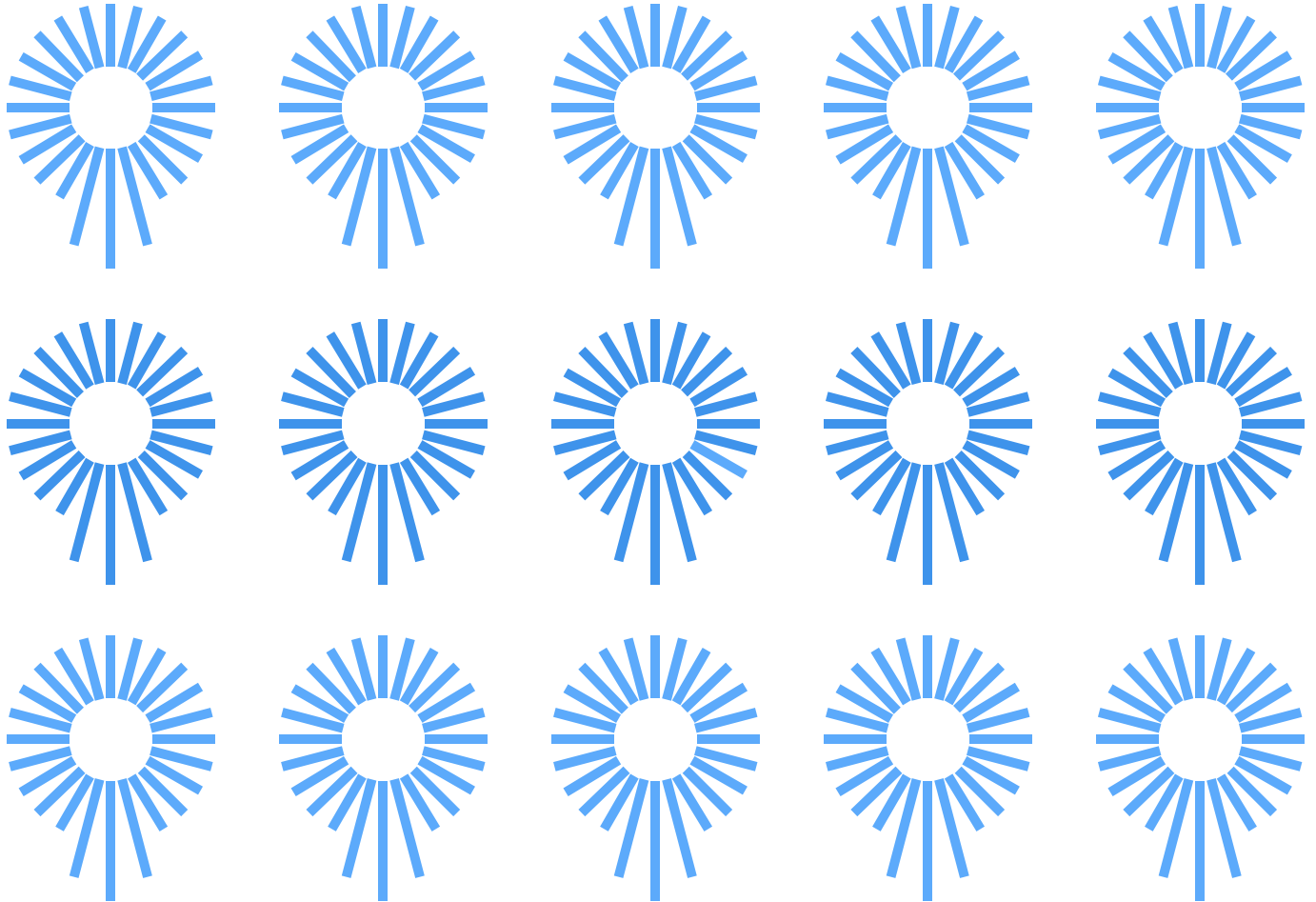

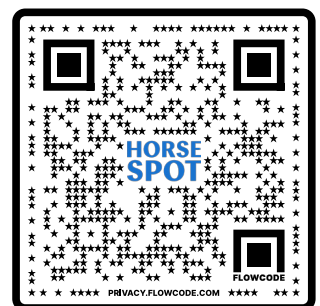
