RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES

- 1. Pre-entries will be accepted until 8:00am the day before each show for Season Pass holders and 8am 72 hours before each show for non members. All other entries submitted after that point will be accepted and charged a \$50 post entry fee if received after the pre-entry deadline.
- 2. Numbers: No numbers will be given out without SIGNED OPEN CHECK or signed Credit Card Authorization Form all required signatures, valid phone number, and all other required information on the entry form must be completed in full. Open check or credit card must be on file for each season/year.

FEES

- 3. All Exhibitors showing will be charged \$50.00 EMT fee, a \$80.00 office fee, and \$5.00 USHJA & Outreach fee per horse. *USEF fee of \$23.00 for drug and admin will be collected. Standard USEF fees will apply. A 4% credit card convenience fee will be added to all entries paid by credit card.
- 4. Class Fees shall be \$50.00/Equitation and Classics, \$40/Hunter/Jumper and Warm up classes, unless otherwise specified amount. Nomination and class fees are indicated with class description.

PAYMENT

- 5. **All entries not paid** by the end of each horse show within 24 hours ,will be considered late and will incur a \$50.00 late payment fee. Office staff will close out open invoices by the payment method being held by the entry. It is the exhibitors responsibility to review each open invoice/bill and dispute at the end of the show or the bill stands without further review.
- 6. **A fine of \$100.00** plus collection fees will be charged for any non-negotiable funds. This includes checks and credit cards. that are declined.(*debit cards not accepted).
- 7. **Refunds**: Entries canceled prior to the closing date of entries will be refunded in full. Stabling, nominating, administration and Credit Card fees will not be refunded under any circumstances. Prior to the start of the competition you may scratch a horse from the show. Please send to the show secretary in writing at ,Entry@ridgeshowjumping.com . Any entry fees will be refunded less a \$150.00 fee will be imposed. We encourage to check your show bill at the end of each show.
- 8. **All scratches** must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund. Horses scratched the day of the show will be subject to a \$25.00 scratch fee. If the show must be stopped due to storm, accident, or other emergency, show management has the right to deny a refund of any fees.
- 9. **All riders/participants:** It is compulsory for all persons at schooling or a Federation licensed, hunter/jumper, equitation jumper, must always wear proper attire and headgear. It must meet or exceed the safety Certified ASTM protective head gear while mounted on the show grounds. Any participant will be asked to leave the rinand or class or show immediately. Rule listed under GR801
- 10. **Schooling** will be permitted only in designated areas provided by the committee and scheduled as time permits. Back numbers must be issued and worn at all times.
- 11. **A jump order** will be established at the in-gate with the starter.
- 12. **All pets** must always be kept on a leash.
- 13. **Sharps containers** will be located in the secretary stand.
- 14. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith., and in accordance with Zone 4 Rules
- 15. Classes will be run in accordance with all leagues/organizations governing each class as listed in the class title.
- 16. **Stalls, if available,** will be 10'x 12' temporary stalls with doors and matted dirt floors. **DRY STALL** \$400 weekly if available, or \$100 per day. Stabling fees subject to Florida sales tax. Please contact: entry@ridgeshowjumping.com prior to arrival to make arrangements.

You will be required to bring your own hay, grain, shavings and buckets. You will be required to clean stall daily and strip stall before you leave. A \$75.00 fee will be assessed for any stall not cleaned or stripped properly.

- 17. A **current negative Coggins and proof of EHV** vaccine will be required for all horses entering the show grounds.]
- 18. All Marshall & Sterling designated classes will be run in accordance with M& S specifications and regulations.
- 19. All Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on soundness and manners.
- 20. **All Horses must be Micro chippe**d and registered with USHJA /USEF and on file with the federations. It must be provided prior to the licenses competition. It is the responsibility of the participant to do this. HU1031,EQ103.2 and JP 100.2. Microship must be 15 digits ISO compliant 11784/11785 and chip be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.

PRIZE MONEY


- 20 . In order for the prize money to be awarded, Prize money payee information must be provided, including name, address, and taxpayer identification number. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank. Each season a new W-9(for the current season) must be filled out and on file with the show office. If there are fewer that 15 entries in a class offering \$1,000 or more in prize money, the class will be held as a sweepstakes with the entry fees combines to make the purse. If there are fewer than 6 entries, a class offering \$3,000 or more in Prize Money will not run. Money will be paid as follows 1st,-30%,2nd-22%,3rd-18%,4th-12%.5th-10%,6th-8%
- 21. Prize Money will be applied to the show accounts. If additional Prize Money needs to be issued, it will be mailed within 30 days using the information provided. A completed W9 is required to be on file with show management. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to provide this information on all entry blanks .Incomplete or missing information will result in money not being issued.* All Prize Money checks are Non-negotiable after 60 days from the date of issue.

MANAGEMENT

- 22. The Committee/Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, change, move, or add classes or substitute classes or schooling as deemed necessary and at their full discretion. Management has ultimate say in all disputes. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and return any fees paid prior to the start of the show without financial obligation or liability. The Committee further has the authority to remove and or refuse anyone or or any horse from the show grounds.
- 23. The Ridge Farm LLC, The Ridge South LLC, The Ridge Grand Prix Tour Group LLC, its employees or owners, Nona Garson, George D'Ambrosio, or any member of the show committee will not be held responsible for any accident, loss, theft, or damage at the show. It shall be the condition of every exhibitor and person on the property to hold the same blameless or harmless for any accident or loss.
- 24. It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations are read, understood, and accepted. 25.
- 25. Equine Zero Liability Florida State Senate Bill 1658. Under Florida Law Equines Zero Liability Statue: Warning under Florida Law an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.



Membership Statement:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Safe Sport Reminder:

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

Motorized Vehicle Statement:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
