DIRECTIONS: 3 Wolverton Road Asbury, NJ 08802 FROM the East heading WEST on ROUTE 78:

Route 78 WEST to EXIT 11, Route 173/West Portal. Off the exit, follow signs to stay on ROUTE 173 WEST; Continue for 2 miles and exit off Route 173 bearing right onto BRUNSWICK AVE. Make the right onto ASBURY/W PORTAL ROAD. Go 1/4 mile, make the first left onto VALLEY STATION ROAD. Cross over the green bridge (Valley Station turns into WOLVERTON Road). The entrance to The Ridge Farm @ Riverview is the first driveway on the left.

FROM the East heading WEST (Truck Route)

Route 78 West to exit 7, Rt 173 West, go approx. ½ mile, make first right (just past Musconetcong River) onto Bloomsbury Asbury Road. Go approx. 2.5 miles turn right onto Wolverton Road. Turn right on first driveway on right.

FROM the West (PA) heading EAST on ROUTE 78


Route 78 EAST to EXIT 6. This is the exit for the Weigh Station. Go to the end of the ramp and make a LEFT onto BL OOMSBURY ROAD. Continue about 2 ½ miles (road becomes Asbury Bloomsbury Road) and make a RIG HT onto WOLVERTON ROAD. The Ridge Farm @ Riverview is the first driveway on the right.

Rules & Regulations

- Post entries will be accepted after noon the day before the show with a \$25.00 post entry fee
- Horses scratched on the day of the show will be charged a \$25 scratch fee.
- A current negative coggins and proof of vaccine will be required for all horses entering the
- show grounds.
 - Schooling will be permitted only in designated areas. back numbers must be issued and worn.
- 10 minute course walk will be offered with each jump height change
 All hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness with an emphasis on
- soundness and manners.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, change or add classes or schooling as deemed necessary.
- ASTM certified headgear is required at all times when mounted on the show grounds. All
 pets must be leashed.
- All fees must be secured and entry forms complete, including required signatures, before a
- number can be issued for any horse.
- It is a condition of entry to the showgrounds that these rules and regulations are read, understood and accepted.
- A \$75 fee will be charged for any non negotiable checks.
 Credit cards will be accepted for payment but please note that a convenience fee will be
- added to the amount due.
- In order for money to be awarded, prize Money payee information must be provided, including name, address, and tax payer identification number. It is the sole responsibility of
- the exhibitor to provide this information on the entry blank.
 Prize money will be applied to show accounts. If additional prize money needs to be issued, it will be mailed withing 30 days using the information provided on the entry blank
- provided a completed W-9 is on file with show management. All Prize money checks are non negotiable after 60 days from the date of issue.

Class 3341 Open to horses and ponies. Two rounds to the derby. Traditional derby round and a handy round. Scored on a numerical system, no high options. May not cross enter into any other section. Warmup class also offered. \$35.00



HUNT TEAMS

Class 3342 Fences not to exceed 2. Teams of three (3 horses/ponies to be shown over a course in the ring, one to follow the other at a safe hunting distance. Combined ownership permitted. Judged on performance, suitability, manners, uniformity, and appearance as a team. Pony/Horse and/or Rider may only compete on one team \$25 per Team Member

Asbury Ring



\$500 HUNTER DERBY

ELIGIBILITY: Open to horses ridden by Juniors, Amateurs or Professionals. Riders are not limited to the number of horses they may ride. Horses and riders may cross enter into any division for which they are otherwise eligible.

JUDGING: To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 will return for the second round in reverse order of their scores. Scores will be added to determine the winners. In the case of a tie, judges will confer to break the tie. Management reserves the right to change the class format of the class to a Hunt N'Go due to number of entries or weather conditions.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS: First Round: To be shown over a hunter classic type course of at least 10 fences. Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence, coop, hedge, brush, logs and natural foliage. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. After the judge's preliminary scores are given, one bonus point will be awarded for each high option chosen. Second Round: To be shown over a hunter handy type course of at least 8 fences. To include elements such as roll-backs, tight turn options, trot jumps, hand gallop, halt and/or back, or work through a gate while mounted. To be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality, substance and movement, handiness and brilliance of pace. Handiness is defined as ground saving movement without adversely affecting performance or style. Brilliance of pace is defined as a faster pace than ordinary, without sacrificing performance or style. Formal attire requested but not required.

\$500 HUNT & GO DERBY

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all riders, horses & ponies

JUDGING: To be scored under the open numerical judging system. A single score will be given.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS: Fences to simulate those found in hunting country, including post and rail, coop, wall, aiken, hedge, brush and log. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality, substance and movement. The class format will consist of two phases (not two rounds, one Classic Hunter Phase, and one Handy Hunter Phase. The phases will be jumped consecutively with no break in pace. All participants will complete both the Classic and the Handy portions even if penalties (rails, refusal, etc.)are incurred. Major penalties (falls, three refusals, off course, etc.)will result in elimination. A single score will be given by the judges. Bonus points of one point per high option jump will be added to the score. Each height section is it's own derby.

AWARDS: Trophy & Ribbons 1st-10th, please ride for ribbons.

Have fun with our signature class joining our day of equestrian sport & generosity! How many jumps can you do in 60 seconds?! How much money can you raise to fight Breastcancer?! Riders in this special class will submit a "Pledge Card" on which they will list sponsors for their performance. Each sponsor on the list will have pledged a particular dollar amount per jump that is done within the time allowed, over a course of fences designed by the rider. Each sponsor's total donation to the fight against breast cancer will be determined by how many jumps the rider can jump in the allotted time. Pledge cards available in advance on our website (www.ridgeshowjumping.com), or on the show day at the office. Sponsor attire permitted, costumes, too! Bring out the Pink!

NO ENTRY FEE CLASS #4000 * Class will start at 18" and go up from there as necessary for all to participate, please declare height on entry blank. * Each competitor has 60 seconds to jump all the obstacles he wishes in any order. * An audible signal declares start and the finish of the round. * Obstacles will be built to be jumped in either direction. * Each obstacle may be jumped only twice. * A competitor will be credited for each obstacle jumped correctly. * No credit is awarded for an obstacle knocked down. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped. * All disobediences are penalized by the time lost by the competitor. The competitor must withdraw after a fall. Nevertheless the rider scores the pledge obtained up to the moment of his or her fall. * One designated obstacle will be provided in the course duly marked by flags and titled "DOUBLE YOUR PLEDGE". This jump is an optional jump, chosen by the rider as to whether to take the opportunity to attempt to clear the obstacle, thereby doubling the total amount pledged. The sponsor has the option to accept or decline the challenge to double their pledge. This jump must be attempted within 60 seconds of the finishing signal of the first round. This option of accepting or declining the doubling of the pledge should be written in advance on the pledge card. Should a sponsor not wish to "gamble" a pledged amount, a capped donation will of course be accepted and appreciated. * Checks will be written to The Breast Cancer Research Foundation, and are considered a fully taxdeductible 501(C)3 donation.
