Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in each division at the end of the show day. Ribbon points values for each class: 7,5,4,3,2,1

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be awarded in each division at end of series. \* Riders must compete in 3 of the 5 shows in the same division to be eligible.

No horse substitutions will be permitted in hunter classes. Points will follow the horse in hunter divisions regardless of the rider. Points will follow the rider in equitation divisions regardless of the horse.

Large indoor ring will be open for paid schooling prior to the start of the show at 8:00 AM.

Brief warm-ups will be offered prior to the start of each division for \$10.00 each. All warm-ups will be run in a safe and orderly manner and limited to a suitable number of horses and riders in the ring at one time. Management reserves the right to modify, combine, or cancel any divisions.

\*Martingales and Grass Reins allowed in flat classes for beginner classes and divisions only jumping cross-rails.



Pre-Walk Trot: Open to riders under 13 who have just come off the leadline. Trainers are allowed in the ring while showing but any adjustments to stirrups or reins will be penalized Diagonals will NOT count. Riders may not cross enter into any other divisions.
