Show Entry Rules

Fees & Refunds: Entries will be accepted through Horsespot

http://amec.horsespot.net

\$15 office/awards fee will be charged for every horse/rider combination. A \$15 service fee will be applied to open checks not closed by conclusion of the show. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK OR CARD ON FILE. Coggins must be submitted through horsespot.

Returned Checks: A \$50 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Stabling: \$95/stall. Shavings \$12/bag (3 bag minimum, No Outside Shavings Allowed). All stalls occupying a horse for more than 1 hour must have shavings spread. Early move-ins/Late move-outs (arriving before 10am Friday, departing after 8pm Sunday) \$35/day. Early reservation of stalls through Horsespot is appreciated. Horses not purchasing a stall will be charged a \$15 grounds fee.

Schooling: Schooling on Friday from 1-6pm, flat only. The arena will also be open for 2 hours of flatting only, Saturday at the conclusion of hunters. There will be no schooling over fences prior to the start of the show. Horses may NOT walk with the riders during the course walk.

<u>Warm-Up Classes:</u> Warm-up classes will be offered over a modified course. Not all elements will be available to jump prior to the Derby / Gambler's Choice.

Horse / Rider Combinations: Each horse may only be entered under 2 riders. Each horse / rider combination may only enter 1 height for jumpers and 1 height for hunters. The cross-over between hunter and jumper division height may not be more than 6". Each horse may only show in each height with one rider.

<u>Non-Showing Entries:</u> Non-showing entries will be charged a non-showing fee of \$40 in addition to stabling/grounds fees (if applicable) and Office fees. Negative coggins is required for non-showing entries as well.

<u>Adds/Scratches:</u> Adds/Scratches will be accepted prior to December 8th at midnight with no additional fee. Scratches after the deadline will be charged the office fee. Late adds will be charged \$25 late fee.

Potluck Dessert Bar: Saturday afternoon

Free to participate, if you bring a dessert that serves 10-15 people. \$5 to participate if you do not bring a dessert. Will be set up during the 2'9" Derby Classic Round

<u>Coggins</u>: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which must be uploaded to Horsespot with entries. CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON HORSESPOT FOR ALL HORSES ENTERING THE SHOW FACILITY.

Prizes

<u>Ribbons, Trophies and Championship:</u> Warm-up classes receive a 1st place prize and 6 ribbons. Derby and Gambler's Choice Classes will have a variety of prizes and/or prize money. Prize money will be the minimum of what is posted on the prize list. Prize money may increase with large amounts of entries and/or sponsorships.

<u>Changes</u>: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money is indicated for each class. Prize money won can be paid by check or deducted from each horse's account. An IRS W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money will be paid. Prize money will be withheld if the recipients Social Security number or EIN number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner unless written authorization, and complete alternate payee information, is on file with the show secretary. All prize money will be paid within 30 days of the shows' conclusion.

1st place \$75. 2nd \$55. 3rd \$38. 4th \$33. 5th \$26. 6th \$23.

Facility Rules

Responsibility: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify & hold harmless Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center Officials against any claim, demands, costs & expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of exhibitor's business or its use of the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against AMEC management because of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceedings by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property & AMEC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire or theft. It is the responsibility of the show management, exhibitors, trainers & spectators to conduct themselves in a civilized & sportsmanlike manner. Waivers will be signed on Horsespot. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT A WAIVER SIGNED.

WARNING: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

<u>Dogs</u>: There will be no dogs on the property that are not attached by a leash to a person's hand!!! Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behavior.

Attire: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be in proper show clothes (jackets) for the derby and gambler's choice. Full show attire is not required for warm-up classes. Braiding is not required, but recommended, for the hunter derby. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible any time riders are mounted on the horse.

<u>Footing:</u> Warm Up arena and indoor arenas are all weather sand composite 150x250. Outdoor Arena is GGT Fiber Footing.

<u>Lunging</u>: Is not permitted in show arenas or warm-up arenas. There is a lunging pad located between the show office and stall barns.

Manure: Must be placed in designated areas. DO NOT dump or spread manure outside of designated areas.

Concessions: Concessions with a full menu will be open: Saturday & Sunday 1 hour prior to start of show through the conclusion of the show.

Parking: Trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load and off-load. Cars will not be allowed to park in the gravel barn/arena area unless handicapped placards are displayed. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS MAY BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.

SATURDAY CLASSES

Saturday Warm-Up: \$35 Entry Fee

Warm-up courses will be judged and pinned to 6th place. Courses will be over a hunter course in the show area, but not all of the derby elements will be included. Holiday sweaters are encouraged in warm-up classes! Classes without 3 entries will be combined.

Class 1: 18" Class 2: 2'3" Class 3: 2'9" Class 4: 3'3"

Class 9: Lead Line Classic: Junior; \$5 Entry Fee

Riders must be under the age of 10. Points are awarded for style, safety, and personality! Horse handlers must be over the age of 15.

Class 10: Lead Line Classic: Adult; \$5 Entry Fee

Riders must be over the age of 20 and have limited horse riding experience. Points are awarded for style, safety, personality, and creativity! Horse handlers may be any age, but must be experienced. Top 10 riders will receive ribbons.

Class 5: \$250 18" FarmVet Hunter Derby: \$45 Entry Fee

Open to Juniors / Amateurs only. 1st round, classic hunter course. High options up to 2' will be offered. Handy Round, top 8 invited back. High options up to 2' will be offered. Riders may be asked to trot a cross-rail fence. No combinations.

Classic & Handy rounds will be placed 1st-8th and given ribbons. Overall placings 1st-8th with neck ribbons.

Placings and prizes will be combined with the 2'3" derby if there are less than 12 entries in both. The winner will receive a half-gallon of GutX and a bridle bag.

Class 7: \$450 2'9" Hunter Diamond Derby:

\$60 Entry Fee

1st round, classic hunter course. High options up to 3' will be offered.

Handy Round, top 12 invited back. Riders may be asked to trot a 2'3" fence. Riders may be asked to jump out of the show arena, complete obstacles in the hunt field, and jump back into the arena. Top placing overall rider will receive a pair of diamond stud earrings from Soph I Livey Equestrian and a half-gallon of GutX. Top placing Jr/Am rider will receive a prize.

Placings and prizes will be combined with the 3'3" derby if there are less than 15 entries in both.

Class 6: \$250 2'3" Bluebonnet Hunter Derby: \$45 Entry Fee

Open to Juniors / Amateurs only. 1st round, classic hunter course. High options up to 2'6" will be offered.

Handy Round, top 8 invited back. High options up to 2'6" will be offered. Riders may be asked to trot an 18" fence. No combinations.

Classic & Handy rounds will be placed 1st-8th and given ribbons. Overall placings 1st-8th with neck ribbons.

Placings and prizes will be combined with the 18" derby if there are less than 12 entries in both. The winner will receive a half-gallon of GutX and a bridle bag.

Class 8: \$550 3'3" Integrity Hunter Derby: \$60 Entry Fee

1st round, classic hunter course. High options up to 3'6" will be offered.

Handy Round, top 12 invited back. High options up to 3'6" will be offered. Riders may be asked to trot a 2'6" fence. Riders may be asked to jump out of the show arena, complete obstacles in the hunt field, and jump back into the arena. Top placing overall rider will receive a pair of diamond stud earrings from Soph I Livey Equestrian and a half-gallon of GutX.

Placings and prizes will be combined with the 2'9" derby if there are less than 15 entries in both.

SUNDAY CLASSES

Sunday Warm-Up: \$35 Entry Fee

Warm-up courses will be Tablell Sec1. Warm-ups will be pinned to 6th place. Courses will be over a jumper course in the show arena, but not all of the Gambler's Choice elements will be included. No combinations.

Class 11: 0.60m-.65m Table II Sec 1

Class 12: 0.80m-.85m Table II Sec 1

Class 13: 1.00m-1.05m Table II Sec 1

Class 14: 1.10m-1.15m Table II Sec 1

Class 19: Lead Line Classic: Junior; \$5 Entry Fee

Riders must be under the age of 10. Points are awarded for style, safety, and personality! Horse handlers must be over the age of 15.

Class 20: Lead Line Classic: Adult; \$5 Entry Fee

Riders must be over the age of 20 and have limited horse riding experience. Points are awarded for style, safety, personality, and creativity! Horse handlers may be any age, but must be experienced. Top 10 riders will receive ribbons.

Gambler's Choice RULES:

All jumps will be assigned a point value. Each jump may be jumped from either direction. Each jump may be jumped twice, unless it is knocked down. For each jump successfully completed, you will receive the points assigned to the jump. No points will be awarded for jumps knocked down. No points will be deducted for refusals, it is just a loss of time on the clock. Riders must cross the designated timer at the beginning AND end of the round. JOKER FENCE:The Joker fence is OPTIONAL. It may ONLY be jumped after your round is complete. Riders must wait for the whistle to be blown again. You will have 20 seconds to complete the Joker fence, and you may only jump it once. You win the designated points if you jump it successfully, but you LOSE the designated points if you knock rails down or fail to jump it within the 20 seconds allowed.

Class 15: \$250 Quail Hollow Gambler's Choice \$45 Entry Fee

Fence heights 0.60m-0.65m. The gambler's choice will be placed 1st-8th based on total points earned. Unsafe riding will be penalized with up to 8 jump faults. NO COMBINATIONS. No professionals. Placings and prizes will be combined with the 0.80m-0.85m if there are less than 12 entries in both. The winner will receive a half-gallon of Gut X and a bridle bag.

Class 17: \$450 GGT Footing Gambler's Choice \$60 Entry Fee

Fence heights 1.00m-1.05m. The gambler's choice will be placed 1st-8th based on total points earned. Unsafe riding will be penalized with up to 8 jump faults. Open to all riders. Placings and prizes will be combined with the 1.10m-1.15m if there are less than 12 entries in both. The winner will receive a half-gallon of Gut X and a pair of open front jumping boots.

Class 16: \$250 100x Equine Gambler's Choice \$45 Entry Fee

Fence heights 0.80m-0.85m. The gambler's choice will be placed 1st-8th based on total points earned. Unsafe riding will be penalized with up to 8 jump faults. NO COMBINATIONS. Open to all riders. Top non-pro award will be given to the highest placing Jr/Am rider. Placings and prizes will be combined with the 0.60m-0.65m if there are less than 12 entries in both. The winner will receive a halfgallon of Gut X and a bridle bag.

Class 18: \$550 Little Feather Gambler's Choice \$60 Entry Fee

Fence heights 1.10m-1.15m. The gambler's choice will be placed 1st-8th based on total points earned. Unsafe riding will be penalized with up to 8 jump faults. Open to all riders. Placings and prizes will be combined with the 1.00m-1.05m if there are less than 12 entries in both. The winner will receive a half-gallon of Gut X and a pair of open front jumping boots.
