RULES AND REGULATIONS

CONDITION OF ENTRY: St. Croix Stables/ Stonegate Farm/

Stonegate Classic Series and Simons Arena and its officers, agents or employees, will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it will be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold the Horse Show and its management blameless for any loss or accident to his/her animal or equipment. The show will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way to participants, spectators, employees or any other party.

The Stonegate Classic Series horse shows reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and to cancel award prizes without claim for damages, to change courses, to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors.

In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

RESPONSIBILITY: All owners, exhibitors and vendors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, employees and horses, to stalls, buildings and other property on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS: Show management reserves the right to decline any entry or post entry at their discretion and to retain any fee before or during the show without liability. Further, it reserves the right to do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Post entries added as time allows.

REFUNDS: Prior to the start of the show, entry fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by a veterinarian or a medical doctor in case of a rider, stating that the horse/rider is unable to perform in the classes entered. Once the horse has shown, show management will accept a statement from the official horse show veterinarian only. Refund requests must be submitted to the show secretary prior to completion of show. Stall fees are not refundable.

RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$50.00 office charge for any checks returned by a bank for any reason. In the event a check is returned after the show's completion, it will be handled in accordance with USEF rules and regulations.

PREMIUM CHECKS: PREMIUMS WILL BE SUBTRACTED FROM PAYMENT DUE.

MEDICAL WASTE: All medical waste must be disposed of in the appropriate manner. Red sharps containers are placed conveniently around the stabling areas.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIPS: Eight ribbons will be offered in every class, unless specified. Championships and reserves will be awarded according to GR 808 for hunters, and JP 110.2 for Jumpers and Equitation Classes.

DOG OWNERS Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW: DECLARE ALL CLASSES the day before classes are held. A TRANSACTION FEE will be charged at \$5.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH SHEET if changes are made on the same day as the classes are held. ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS WITHOUT HAVING FILLED OUT THE PAPERWORK, WILL BE CHARGED A \$10.00 FEE EACH TIME.

ORDER OF GO: Show management may determine a rotating order of go using a computer. Riders who have a conflict should report to the paddock master. Order of go will be posted in the paddock area.

ATTIRE: Riders must be neatly attired when competing. Any person not suitably attired may be barred at the discretion of the show management. The use of any device with ear bud(s) while mounted is prohibited in all hunter and jumper schooling rings. It is compulsory for all persons at Stonegate hunter, jumper or hunter/ jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

SAFETY: In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a Stonegate competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional.

ATTENTION

PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES WITHIN 12 MONTHS. THIS IS A STATE LAW. PROOF OF FLU/RHINO VACCINATION WITHIN 6 MONTHS MUST BE PRESENTED PER USEF. THESE MUST BE PRESENTED BEFORE NUMBERS WILL BE GIVEN OUT.

An Official "Non-Showing Horse" is required to pay the stall fee and a \$125.00 Non-Showing Fee in addition to the Office Fee.

JUMPERS: A Rotating pre-posted jumping order may be established in all classes and posted in the paddock area at least one-half hour before the class is to begin. Any horse schooling except over the designated practice jumps shall be disqualified. Jumps and courses in any or all classes are subject to change at the discretion of the committee, in the case of a jump-off, damage to equipment or for any other reason. Show management reserves the right to alter the heights and spreads of the fences as competition warrants. Charts and courses will be posted in the paddock area. Management reserves the right to change jumper tables, after due notice to exhibitors. Jump orders may be computer drawn. Ties for other than first place in Jumper Classes and the Mini Prix will be decided on the basis of faults and time in the first round. MONEY CLASS ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a money and/or jackpot class, entry must have entered and shown in at least one other class in that division. Ten entries required for class to be held.

To be shown over a course of not less than 8 obstacles not exceeding 3' in height which must include one combination, one change of direction, and one long approach to a fence. Two or more tests of the top four riders are required, USEF Tests 1-14. Only one rider per horse. Amateur riders in this class may cross enter into classes where fences are 3'6" or higher. Junior riders in this class may not cross enter, at the same show, into classes where fences are 3'6" or higher unless they are in their first year of

showing over fences 3'6" or higher; except for the Medal Final class, where they may cross enter if otherwise qualified. First through fourth place winners shall be eligible to compete in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal Final. The final for this class in 2024 will be held at the Mid States Fall Horse Show. The winner of the final will receive a perpetual trophy. Qualifying for the Medal shall start with the first MHJA Medal class held after the Medal finals of the previous year and end at the last show prior to the finals of the current year. In the event no final class is held, the perpetual trophy shall be awarded to the rider who has accumulated the most points in the MHJA Hunt Seat Medal class throughout the year.

Class 228 MHJA MINI-MEDAL Entry Fee \$35.00

Open to junior and amateur riders who are current members of the MHJA. Application for membership must be made directly to the MHJA. Cross entry at the same show into any class where the height of fences exceeds 2'9" is prohibited. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences 2'6" in height. Two tests (1-8) are required in the first round. If there are 8 or more entries at the beginning of the class, two or more tests of the top four riders are required. USEF tests 1-8. Only one rider per horse. A final for this class in 2024 will be held at the Fall Mid States Horse Show. Riders who win a first, second, third or fourth place in the Mini-Medal will be eligible for the finals. Exhibitors who qualify in both the Mini-Medal and the MHJA Medal may ride in only one final.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES Riders in Opportunity Classes may not show in any USEF Rated classes at the same horse show. Riders may cross enter into unrated classes for which they are eligible provided the height of fences does not exceed 2'6". Entries are not required to have USEF/USHJA membership or pay the nonmember fee, and their horse or pony need not be registered with USHJA or recorded with USEF to participate in these classes. Entries are required to pay all other fees. If riders or horses enter in any other classes at the show, they ARE required to have all necessary memberships (or pay nonmember fees) and registrations. Any rider that has, in the last five (5) years, competed in any rated hunter section or an Equitation class with a National year-end final is not eligible to compete in any Opportunity classes or sections. Attire may consist of proper hunter/jumper show attire or the following: breeches with paddock boots and half chaps, jodhpurs with paddock boots, or breeches and boots. Hunter/Equitation riders may wear a shirt with a tie or a show shirt with a choker.

ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR APPROVED HEAD GEAR. Martingales are not permitted in Flat or Under Saddle Classes. please enter, FULL refund if unable to attend.

Ground Poles OPPORTUNITY Entry Fee: \$30.00/Class

Riders in this division may not cross enter into any other division or class at the same horse show, except classes on the flat and under saddle classes for which they are otherwise eligible. Classes may consist of unmounted showmanship, walk-trot, walk-trot-canter and cross rails. Cross rail courses shall be once around the ring on the rail, with no diagonal lines. Trotting not to be penalized in cross rail class. In flat/under saddle classes, no more than 6 entries to canter at one time. Manners emphasized and extreme speed to be penalized. If a rider has more than one entry in a Ground Pole Hunter class, only the top placing entry will be counted.
