#### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

#### CONDITION OF ENTRY: St. Croix Stables/Stonegate Farm/

Stonegate Classic Series and Simons Arena and its officers, agents or employees, will in no way be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur and it will be a condition of entry that each participant shall hold the Horse Show and its management blameless for any loss or accident to his/her animal or equipment. The show will not be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen and will not be responsible or liable for injury sustained in any way to participants, spectators, employees or any other party.

The Stonegate Classic Series horse shows reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and to cancel award prizes without claim for damages, to change courses, to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors.

In the event of an acute and serious injury to or illness of a horse on competition grounds when the owner or trainer of the horse or agent of the owner is not present, after reasonable effort to contact that individual has been made, competition management, in consultation with a licensed equine veterinarian, may authorize the provision of emergency veterinary treatment of the horse. If competition management so authorizes treatment under the provisions of this rule, competition management and veterinarian are not liable for any resulting costs, damages, losses, claims or actions arising directly or indirectly from the treatment of the horse.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** All owners, exhibitors and vendors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, employees and horses, to stalls, buildings and other property on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

**PARENTS** If not accompanying minors, please send Permission for Medical Treatment (responsibility for care) w/ trainer or responsible adult.

**CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS:** Show management reserves the right to decline any entry or post entry at their discretion and to retain any fee before or during the show without liability. Further, it reserves the right to do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Post entries added as time allows.

**REFUNDS:** Prior to the start of the show, entry fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a statement signed by a veterinarian or a medical doctor in case of a rider, stating that the horse/rider is unable to perform in the classes entered. Once the horse has shown, show management will accept a statement from the official horse show veterinarian only. Refund requests must be submitted to the show secretary prior to completion of the show. Stall fees are not refundable.

**RETURNED CHECKS:** There will be a \$50.00 office charge for any checks returned by a bank for any reason. In the event a check is returned after the show's completion, it will be handled in accordance with USEF rules and regulations.

#### PREMIUM CHECKS: PREMIUMS WILL BE SUBTRACTED FROM PAYMENT DUE.

MEDICAL WASTE: All medical waste must be disposed of in the appropriate manner. Red sharps containers are placed conveniently around the stabling areas.

**RIBBONS, TROPHIES AND CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Eight ribbons will be offered in every class, unless specified. Championships and reserves will be awarded according to GR 808 for hunters, and JP 110.2 for Jumpers and Equitation Classes.

**DOG OWNERS** Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors.

ADDS/SCRATCHES DURING SHOW: DECLARE ALL CLASSES the day before classes are held. A TRANSACTION FEE will be charged at \$5.00 PER ADD/SCRATCH

#### SHEET if changes are made on the same day as the classes are held. ANY ENTRY RIDING IN A CLASS WITHOUT HAVING FILLED OUT THE PAPERWORK, WILL BE CHARGED A \$10.00 FEE EACH TIME.

**ORDER OF GO:** Show management may determine a rotating order of go using a computer. Riders who have a conflict should report to the paddock master. Order of go will be posted in the paddock area.

**ATTIRE:** Riders must be neatly attired when competing. Any person not suitably attired may be barred at the discretion of the show management. The use of any device with ear bud(s) while mounted is prohibited in all hunter and jumper schooling rings. It is compulsory for all persons at Stonegate hunter, jumper or hunter/ jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured.

SAFETY: In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a Stonegate competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional.

#### ATTENTION

PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES WITHIN 12 MONTHS. THIS IS A STATE LAW. PROOF OF FLU/RHINO VACCINATION WITHIN 6 MONTHS MUST BE PRESENTED PER USEF. THESE MUST BE PRESENTED BEFORE NUMBERS WILL BE GIVEN OUT.

RV hook ups must be ordered in advance with your stall. All Plugs are 30 Amp. No Sewer. Some sites have water.

OFFICE CHARGE: An office charge of \$50.00 per horse will be assigned to each entry.

MEDIC FEE: A medic fee of \$45.00 per horse will be assigned to each entry.

**NON-SHOWING HORSE** - A horse may be entered as "NONSHOWING" on the original entry form at the time the entry blank is submitted by writing "Non-Showing" in the area of the entry blank where classes would normally be entered. An Official "Non- Showing Horse" is required to pay the stall fee and a \$125.00 Non-Showing Fee in addition to the Office Fee.

STALL FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. NO STALL WILL BE RESERVED UNLESS STALL FEES ARE PAID BY THE CLOSING OF ENTRIES. NO TYING TO TRAILERS, NO EXCEPTIONS. ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE A STALL.

#### POST ENTRIES: ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER CLOSING DATE WILL BE ASSESSED A \$50.00 PER HORSE POST ENTRY FEE.

**STABLING:** All stalls are temporary 8 x 16 with swing doors and rubber mats or concrete floors. Limited Tack & Grooming Stalls available. The cost of stabling is \$200.00 per week.

#### **Membership Statement:**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular

Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7)assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

#### Safe Sport Reminder:

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be

eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

#### **Motorized Vehicle Statement:**

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hoverboards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed

"unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

JUMPERS: A Rotating pre-posted jumping order may be established in all classes and posted in the paddock area at least one-half hour before the class is to begin. Any horse schooling except over the designated practice jumps shall be disqualified. Jumps and courses in any or all classes are subject to change at the discretion of the committee, in the case of a jump-off, damage to equipment or for any other reason. Show management reserves the right to alter the heights and spreads of the fences as competition warrants. Charts and courses will be posted in the paddock area. Management reserves the right to change jumper tables, after due notice to exhibitors. Jump orders may be computer drawn. Ties for other than first place in Jumper Classes and the Mini Prix will be decided on the basis of faults and time in the first round. MONEY CLASS ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible for a money and/or jackpot class, entry must have entered and shown in at least one other class in that division. Ten entries required for class to be held.

**JUMPER NOMINATION FEE:** All jumpers must pay a nomination fee except Low, Medium and High Schooling, Young Jumpers, 1.20m, and Low Children's Adult Jumper section. Children's/Adult Jumper/Modified Child Adult \$85, all others \$200. This fee is in addition to the declaration (entry fee)

Conduct outside of the competition ring: Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor, deemed excessive by a judge, Steward, Management, or Competition Veterinarian anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning or elimination from the class. Such action(s) could include, but are not limited to: excessive or improper use of the whip, spurs, reins, rider's weight or rider's hands; lunging a visibly exhausted horse; lunging an obviously lame horse; chasing a horse with a lunge whip or other inappropriate use of the whip; the use of a lunge whip with any type of appendage or attachment, including but not limited to bags and flags; excessive and/or disruptive cracking of the whip. In addition, after consultation with the Competition Manager and a Competition Steward, additional penalties, including one or more of the following: the issuance of an official warning card, disqualification from competing within the upcoming 24-hour period, or disqualification from the balance of the competition.
