SHOW GROUND REQUIREMENTS

VACCINATIONS/COGGINS: Present record of flu/rhino vaccination (within 6 months) & current negative coggins documentation prior to unloading any horses. Email to modiamondhja@gmail.com. No exceptions will be made, and anyone in violation will be asked to leave the showgrounds.

SCHOOLING: October 25 & 26

- **Saturday Schooling** Opens for flat work, crossrails, and ground poles at 7:30-8:30 AM; Schooling breaks for jumping are noted in the class lists. *Parent/guardian or trainer must accompany any minors on horseback at all times when in the arena.*
 - **Warm Up Arena** will be available for flat work. Please only use the jumping arena for schooling jumps.
 - Round pen available for any horses needing lunged. **No lunging in the arenas or in open areas on the showgrounds.**
- **Sunday Schooling** opens for flatwork, crossrails, 18", and 0.60m 7:30 AM-8:30 AM. Schooling breaks for jumping are noted in the class lists. *Parent/guardian or trainer must accompany any minors on horseback at all times when in the arena.*
 - **Warm Up Arena** will be available for flat work. Please only use the jumping arena for schooling jumps.
 - Round pen available for any horses needing lunged. **No lunging in the arenas or in open areas on the showgrounds.**
- No more than 8 horses in the flat arena at one time and no more than 10 horses in the jumping arena at a time. We ask that you respect the announcer when they announce that schooling is closing.
- Showing Exhibition ("not to be judged") will be permitted for \$15 per class. Non-showing horses are permitted, \$25 for the day per horse or \$40 for both days.

Parking: One-way traffic only; see attached Map for parking. Volunteers will be on-site to help direct parking. Large trailers 3 horse with living quarters or 4 horse or larger will park behind the hay barn. Small trailers will park in the gravel lot in front of the hay barn. Spectator parking will be along the drive.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome, but lawn chairs are recommended. Please sit in the designated areas only!

No canopies or tents are allowed, and the spectator areas are covered and out of the sun! **No Dogs** on show grounds at any time.

SHOW GROUND REQUIREMENTS

Code of Conduct: Excerpt from MDHJA By-Laws, all participating or individuals present on show grounds agree to abide by our organization's by-laws when completing entry forms, signing liability forms, or entering the property.

- 1) The following will not be tolerated by MDHJA; anything not explicitly stated below will be determined using the USEF code of conduct:
 - a) Any physical abuse of horses on the show grounds
 - b) The use of profane language, derogatory slang, or gestures towards members, the association, spectators, or fellow competitors.
 - c) Assault or Harassment – using words that intimidate, threaten or persecute others
 - d) Stealing or cheating
 - e) Intentionally destroying property or the defiance of authority or stated rules.
 - f) Harassing or speaking to the judge while the show is running.
 - g) Changing courses or moving jumps without explicit permission from the show management.
- 2) Any violation of the code of conduct may result in any, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a) A verbal reprimand, a warning letter from the MDHJA board, immediate elimination from a round or division, immediate disqualification from the horseshow, or expulsion from MDHJA.

Liabilities:

- 1) The association is not liable for any risks that may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of members and participants actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the MDHJA Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of members and participants knowingly assume all such risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that may be incurred as a result of their participation in any MDHJA Events. Members and Participants also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by themselves, their horse, other participants, volunteers, or spectators during any MDHJA Event
 - a) Under Missouri law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to the Revised Statutes of Missouri.
- 2) Participation in any MDHJA show or event assumes the participant agrees with the following statement:
 - a) I am voluntarily participating in the Missouri Diamond Hunter Jumper Association in the association and any ancillary activities related thereto, entirely at my own risk. Accordingly, I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless MDHJA and all of its affiliates, managers, members, agents, attorneys, staff, volunteers, representatives, predecessors, successors, and assigns and further releases them from liability for any and all claims or causes of action for accident, injury, property damage or otherwise to the undersigned or to any property or any horse owned by the undersigned or to any family member or spectator accompanying the undersigned to any MDHJA-sanctioned activity. I agree to voluntarily give up or waive any right that I otherwise have to bring any legal action against MDHJA. By becoming a member or completing a show entry form, I agree to the above statements.

Missouri Diamond Hunter Jumper Divisions

HUNTER/EQUITATION

Healing Hands Veterinary Service's Leadline (Walk Only): is open to riders of all ages. A qualified horse leader must lead or control the horse or pony. Riders may not enter any other classes. ASTM-approved headgear and footwear with heels are mandatory. To qualify for year-end awards, leadline riders must participate in at least two separate shows.

1. Leadline

Children's Ground Pole Hunter: is open to any horse or pony and exhibitor under the age of 18 of any showing experience. Courses should not contain a change of direction. At the same show, riders may not cross-enter any division with fences higher than Next Steps Hunter crossrails. The course will consist of 4 poles on the ground. Trot is not required in the over-poles class. Walk and trot are required in the flat class.

2. Hunter Over Fences I
3. Hunter Over Fences II
4. Under Saddle

Adult Amateur Ground Poles Hunter: is open to all adult amateur exhibitors. Courses should not contain a change of direction. At the same show, riders may not cross-enter any division with fences higher than Next Steps Hunter crossrails. The course will consist of 4 poles on the ground. Trot is not required in the over-poles class. Walk and trot are required in the flat class.

Ground Pole Equitation: is open to junior and adult amateur riders of any showing experience. Walk and trot, canter not required. At the same show, riders may not cross-enter any division with fences higher than Next Steps Hunter crossrails.

SCHOOLING BREAK (15 minutes)

Next Steps Hunter Crossrail: is open to any junior or adult amateur rider. It includes a course of 4 fences matching the ground poles pattern. At the same show, riders may not cross-enter any division other than the ground poles division or Crossrail equitation. Walk and trot are required in the flat class. **Fence height: X's only to a maximum of 18" *Not a MOHJO Division***

HUNTER/EQUITATION

Sylvia Pearl Co.'s Children's Crossrail Hunter: is open to any horse or pony and exhibitor under the age of 18 of any showing experience. This class consists of 8 jumps. Walk and trot, canter not required. At the same show, riders may cross-enter the Crossrail equitation and the 18" puddle divisions.

Fence height: X's only to a maximum of 18"

13. Hunter Over Fences I

15. Under Saddle

Adult Amateur Crossrail Hunter: is open to any horse or pony and exhibitor 18 years or older of any showing experience. This class consists of 8 jumps. Walk and trot, canter not required. At the same show, riders may cross-enter the 18" puddle divisions. **Fence height: X's only to a maximum of 18"**

16. Hunter Over Fences I

18. Under Saddle

Crossrail Equitation: is open to junior and adult amateur riders of any showing experience. This class consists of 6 jumps. Walk and trot, canter not required. At the same show, riders may cross-enter either the 18" puddle division or the Ground Poles depending on Crossrail Hunter class. **Fence height: X's only to a maximum of 18"**

SCHOOLING BREAK (15 minutes)

Children's Puddle Hunter (18"): is open to any horse or pony and exhibitor under the age of 18 of any showing experience. Courses may require a change of direction; fences are to be set as verticals, without boxes, oxers, or spreads. Simple changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter either the 2' division or the crossrails at the same show. **Fence Height: 18"**

23. Under Saddle

Adult Amateur Puddle Hunter (18"): is open to any horse or pony and exhibitor 18 years or older of any showing experience. Courses may require a change of direction; fences are to be set as verticals, without boxes, oxers, or spreads. Simple changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter either the 2' division or the crossrails at the same show. **Fence Height: 18"**

Missouri Diamond Hunter Jumper Divisions

HUNTER/EQUITATION

18" Puddle Equitation: is open to junior and adult amateur riders of any showing experience. Courses may require a change of direction; fences are to be set as verticals, without boxes, oxers, or spreads. Simple changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter either the 2' division or the crossrails at the same show. **Fence height: 18"**

SCHOOLING BREAK (15 minutes)

Short Stirrup Hunter (2'): is open to any horse or pony ridden by a junior exhibitor **under the age of 12** by December 1 of the current show year. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. The course consists of eight fences with no combinations. **Fence height: 2'**

Short Stirrup Equitation: is open to juniors under the age of 12 with any show experience. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'**

Long Stirrup Hunter (2'): is open to any horse or pony ridden by a junior exhibitor **between the ages of 12-17** as of December 1st of the current show year. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'**

Long Stirrup Equitation (2'): is open to juniors from age 12-17 of any showing experience. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'**

HUNTER/EQUITATION

Adult Amateur Beginner Hunter (2'): is open to any horse or pony and exhibitor 18 years or older of any showing experience. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'**

Masters Rider Hunter (2'): is open to any horse or pony ridden by an Amateur Adult exhibitor who has reached their 50th birthday before December 1 of the current show year. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'**

Adult Amateur 2' Equitation: is open to adult amateur riders of any showing experience. Fences should be set as verticals with no oxers. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'3" division or the 18" puddle division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'**

SCHOOLING BREAK (15 minutes)

Huffman Hurdle's Pony Hunter (2'3'): is open to any pony, 14.2 hands or smaller, ridden and handled by a junior exhibitor. Courses may contain oxers with a maximum spread of 2'3". Riders will be expected to show at the walk, trot, and canter in the flat class at the judge's discretion. Riders may cross-enter either the 2'6" division or the 2' division at the same show.

Fence Height: 2'3"

Intermediate Hunter (2'3"): is open to any Junior or Amateur Adult exhibitor. Courses may contain oxers with a maximum spread of 2'3". Riders may cross-enter either the 2'6" division or the 2' division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'3"**

Riders may cross-enter either the 2'6" division or the 2' division at the same show. **Fence height: 2'3"**

Low Hunter (2'6"): is open to any exhibitor. Courses may contain oxers with a maximum spread of 2'6". Riders may cross-enter either the 3'3" division or the 2'9" division at the same show. **Fence height: 3'**

JUMPER FUN CLASSES

(No points toward Year End Awards)

Withes Brew Jump Off:

102. Open to all riders and horses; riders will be asked to jump up to 2 fences while holding a plastic cup of liquid. The rider that spills the least amount of liquid jumping wins. Fence Height max of 2'.

Costume Contest:

103. Costumes can be mounted or unmounted. All costumes are welcome unless deemed unsafe or explicitly offensive by the show manager. Walk only. ASTM-approved headgear and closed-toed shoes are mandatory.
