


ONLINE ENTRIES AND PAYMENT @ NMSHOWS.HORSESPOT.NET

All entries be prepared for check-in at office to verify classes with documents:

1. Signed Liability Waiver. A signature by the parent is required if a minor is showing.
2. Copies of AHA, ABRA APHA, WDAA, AQHA membership cards as applicable.
3. Copies of Horse's Registration Papers for those competing in AHA, ABRA, APHA, AQHA or classes. All Breed do not need any registration papers.
4. Fees Payable to AHANM. Open check or CC at check-in is acceptable. Deposit of \$25 for online entry confirmation with credit card. Back numbers released with CC saved on Horsespot or open, signed check at office. You may email your printed entry and handle payment at check-in.

No Physical MAIL entries. Enter online or email only.

Exhibitors showing in AHA Amateur Owner classes must be listed as an owner of the horse on the registration papers of the horse they are exhibiting. Every owner, trainer, rider, driver, handler and parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor must sign the entry form waivers and must be an AHA Competition Member or pay the nonmember/single event fees and Non-Member Fees (A/HA/AA only). A horse must be entered in the name of his/her recorded owner. The complete address and phone number of the recorded owner must be given, even if an agent enters the horse. No horses may be entered on more than one form.



AHA REQUIREMENTS: (Showing in AHA classes)

EVERY AHA CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH FOR AHA ENTRIES.

This horse show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Arabian Horse Division. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. This premium list is based on the rules of the current Rule Book. Any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of this premium list. Each participant in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF rules and its decisions will be final. , ABRA, and classes will be conducted by their rules by sanctioned organizations.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: EACH COMPETITOR (THIS INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE RECORDED OWNER AND ALL TRAINERS, DRIVERS, RIDERS, HALTER HANDLERS, COACHES AND THE PERSON(S) SIGNING THE ENTRY BLANK) IN AN ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZED ARABIAN DIVISION, AT THE TIME OF ENTRY INTO A COMPETITION, MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF A VALID AHA MEMBERSHIP/COMPETITION CARD, JOIN AHA OR PAY AN AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP FEE PER COMPETITOR. WHEN AN AGENT SIGNS FOR THE OWNER AT AN AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITION, BOTH THE OWNER AND AGENT MUST BE MEMBERS OF AHA OR PAY THE AHA SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP. SINGLE EVENT MEMBERSHIP IS NOT ACCEPTABLE AT AHA REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN WALK-TROT CLASSES ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS AT QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS, BUT MUST HAVE AN AHA MEMBERSHIP WITH COMPETITION CARD AT AHA REGIONAL AND NATIONAL COMPETITIONS. EXHIBITORS IN LEAD LINE CLASSES OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS SIGNING FOR MINORS ARE EXEMPT FROM AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS.

- A) At Chamisa Classic AVS Show, all exhibitors entered in A/HA/AA classes must be a current AHA member with a competition card, join AHA at the show, or pay a Single Event Membership fee of \$40.00 per person. This includes any owner, trainer, driver, rider, or halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horse. A photocopy of your AHA membership card must accompany your entry.**
- B) AHA Membership affidavits are no longer available. If you do not have your AHA card you must pay the single event Member fee.**
- C) There is an AHA fee of \$12.00 per horse per judge. \$24 for all AHA entered horses for double judged class 9-90 and recording fee.**

AHANM Non-Member/Insurance Fee: To participate in AHANM shows, all exhibitors will need to be a member of AHANM (Club 8082 with AHA) or pay the Non-Member Insurance Fee at each individual show. A paid membership option is good for 1 year and is required for eligibility for year-end high point awards through AHANM Points earned with non-member fee will NOT count towards award standings. All-Breeds are also encouraged to join and be part of the high point program which includes many awards, including a saddle, to non-Arabians. New Associate membership for adult is \$25 annually and first-time **youth FREE** for 2025. **THIS APPLIES TO ALL BREED, APHA, ABRA, Gymkhana, Exceptional and AHA CLASS ENTRIES.**

APHA and ABRA approved classes will be governed by their current respective rulebooks. Americanbuckskin.com or APHA.com.

ARENAS: The indoor arenas are 117' x 250'; Outdoor arenas are 125' x 264'. Footing in all arenas and warm up areas is sandy loam. ****Indoor/Outdoor Arenas will be available for schooling on Wed April 2 after 12pm, Dairy Barn not until Thurs April 3rd after 3pm.**

BAD CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: There will be a \$50.00 handling fee charged for any returned check or declined credit card. Action in accordance with USEF rules will be taken against any owner, exhibitor or trainer who does not make a returned check/declined credit card charge good and will be reported to AHA or other sanctioned organizations.

BARN OFFICE: Barn manager is Margie Billau (505) 980-6806. Early arrival or late departure is \$35 per day per stall used. **NEW MEXICO AHANMGROUNDS AND/OR AHANM IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ITEMS LEFT UNATTENDED.**

CALL FOR CLASSES: The two-minute gate will be enforced. The gate will close two minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than two minutes, after the entry of the final horse in a continuous string of horses. If tack changes are necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the gate person and request a three-minute gate hold. Note: Due to unforeseeable problems with the mechanical devices, the paddock and barn calls over the PA system must be considered a COURTESY. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES DUE TO EMERGENCIES: In the event that a class, or a series of classes, or all or part of the competition is cancelled due to an accident, storm, or other emergency after the start of the show (defined as initial Move-In Day), classes may be rescheduled or refunded. Classes are subject to change.

DOGS: Dogs will be permitted on the show grounds but **MUST** be always on leashes. No dogs will be allowed in the show arena.

DRESSAGE CLASSES:

FOR DRESSAGE/WESTERN DRESSAGE—*****POST ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED*****

Dressage classes may not run in order listed in the schedule. Maximum of 55 rides/day available – Maximum of three (3) rides per horse/day. Dressage entries must be online or e-mailed. No hand carried entries accepted. Ride Times will be available on the AHANM Website www.nmarabs.org and Facebook page. Once ride times are sent/posted they will not change without Management approval. Limit of 55 rides based on entry submission order! **Dressage Coordinator is Teresa Heine hawaiianwhitechick@yahoo.com.

ENTRIES: All entries must be made on the official entry blank for this show or on the online entry system. A horse must be entered in the name of his registered owner(s) only and must be entered under its full registered name. A photocopy of all AHA, WDAA, ABRA, AQHA membership cards and registration papers will be copied for check-in. All entries must be accompanied by an open check or credit card on file for all fees made out to AHANM. A signature is required by the parent if a minor is showing on liability and show forms. *Open check or credit card info required at check-in. Checks will be deposited upon receipt.* Exhibitor Numbers will be released to exhibitors **ONLY** when ALL open payment form, signatures and information are complete. **Closing Date for Pre-Entries – March 25, 2026.**

FARRIER: A farrier will be on-call. Info at office.

FEED & BEDDING: Feed and bedding is available on the fairgrounds from the show office. The use of outside shavings is not permitted on fairgrounds. If a medical condition requires the use of special bedding, please provide proper documentation from a licensed veterinarian. Shavings may be PRE-ORDERED on your entry form.

HEALTH REGULATIONS: State requirements can be found at NMLB website. Any animals brought into New Mexico must observe all regulations of the State of New Mexico, Animal Health Division. Any horse that develops a communicable disease must be removed from the show grounds.

INDEBTEDNESS TO SHOW: Any exhibitor who fails to settle his/her indebtedness to this show will automatically be reported to AHA and collections processes pursued.

JUDGES: This show will be judged according to the single judge systems for All Breed, ABRA, APHA, H/J, Sport Horse In-Hand, Dressage and Western Dressage. Arabian recognized classes are concurrent. If an official is unable to perform his duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute an official according to USEF rules for AHA classes. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive or made with intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging and any exhibitor may be barred from the show for this offense by the Show Committee. No contact shall be made with the Judges during the period of the show unless accompanied by a member of the Show Committee designated by the committee for such purpose. Further, no exhibitor shall approach a Judge regarding a decision unless he first obtains permission from the Steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time and place.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Golf Carts and Other Motorized Vehicles – To operate any motorized vehicle on the New Mexico Expo grounds, you must have a valid driver's license or operator's license as defined by the state in which you reside. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule. Golf carts must be registered with NMSF to be driven anywhere on the fairgrounds.

****Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.**

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

POST ENTRIES: NO Post Entries will be accepted for Dressage, or Western Dressage classes. Post entries will be accepted for all other classes with an increased office fee of \$40. Entry close date is March 25 ,2025. No additional fee per class for pre-entries to add additional classes at the show.

PRIZE LIST CHANGES AND/OR CORRECTIONS: Changes and/or corrections to the Premium, if any, will be posted on the Club's website www.nmarabs.org and Facebook page for AHANM.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.

PROTESTS. Any protest must be made in accordance with USEF rules governing protests.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES/PROTESTS: The show Management will be governed by USEF rules with respect to refusal of entries. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. **Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason including but not limited to unsportsmanlike like conduct and animal cruelty.**

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS: Horses shown in the Arabian, ABRA, APHA, and AQHA Divisions must have been issued a certificate of registration from their Association and must be entered under their full registered name. Horses shown in the Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry and entered under their registered name. Does not apply to All Breed classes.

RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither Arabian Horse Association of New Mexico nor the EXPO Fairgrounds will be responsible for any loss, personal injury, or damage to any horse exhibited or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost or destroyed or in any way damaged. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor who will be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury of any person, animal or property occasioned by him or his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Arabian Horse Association of New Mexico and the New Mexico AHANM grounds against any and all legal costs, including attorney fees which may be the result thereof. The submitting of any entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of the provisions herein set forth.

SCRATCHING CLASSES: Fees will only be charged for classes shown.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: Show Office will be open April 1 After 6pm. Check-in appointments are encouraged for groups of 6 or more. The show office will remain open throughout the show and will close 30 minutes after the last

class of the show each day. Please remember to check out after your last class. Management reserves right to fill in open checks or charge credit cards at show completion.

STALLIONS are not allowed in showmanship or walk-trot classes for AHA, ABRA youth, or APHA youth.

STALLS: Horse Stalls & Tack Stalls are available for \$35/ night. Stalls and alleyways must be kept clean. Horse tie out is available with a ground tie fee of \$35 per day per horse, not overnight. Please reserve stalls on entry forms. Early Arrival/Late Departure is \$35/stall/night. Stalls are 10 x 10 with a split of full sliding door. Early or Late Arrivals, please contact the Barn Manager.

VETERINARIAN: A veterinarian will not be on the fairgrounds. Information for the on-call vet/surgery center will be posted at Show Office.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Entries may be scratched from the show PRIOR TO March 25, 2025 with a refund of all fees EXCEPT the office fee. After that date, withdrawals will only receive class fees as refund.

DEFINITIONS & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

AHA DEFINITIONS: The following abbreviations, as defined, will be used to describe class specifications:

JOTR/JOTD — Junior Owner to Ride/Junior Owner to Drive.

AOTR/AOTD — Am Owner to Ride/Am Owner to Drive.

JRTR/JRTD — Junior Exhibitor to Ride/Junior Exhibitor to Drive.

ATR/ATD/AATR/—Am to ride/drive

All-Breed Classes: Are for any breed and DO NOT need Registration Papers. All-Breed classes are Open to ANY BREED. Martingales, hackamores, humane training devices and two hands are allowed in ALL All-Breed classes. Show clothes and equipment are not necessary but may be worn in All-Breed classes. Non-member insurance fee or membership to AHANM required for exhibitors, unless proof of club membership is provided by exhibitor or Associate Membership paid with entires.

Amateur —AHA: Every Adult rider having reached his/her 19th birthday prior to 12/1/25 of the previous year must have an amateur card issued by USEF.

Amateur —: Adults who have reached age 19 as of 1/1/26.

AHA Amateur Owners –Leased horses are not eligible for amateur owner classes. Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR122. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this requirement. (Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted.)

Dressage/Western Dressage **Class Information**

Dressage & Western Dressage classes may not be scheduled in order shown. Depending on number of entries, this class schedule may be altered. For western dressage, Show Management reserves the right to limit any horse/rider combination to a maximum of two consecutive levels. Current Dressage and 2022 WDAA tests will be used. Exhibitors may enter multiple AQHA/WDAA/AHA or All-Breed classes with the same test being ridden once. All class fees for each recognition must be paid to receive credit.

for Dressage or Western Dressage . ALL Rides must be pre-entered by closing date of March 25, 2026. **WE WILL NOT ADD RIDE TIMES AT THE SHOW.**

Sport Horse In-Hand Information

In-Hand classes will run on an Open Card. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to follow the speed at which the classes are progressing and to be present at the appropriate time for each go. Management may post a schedule if entries warrant.

TBA Classes: Any class may be added in the spaces with "TBA" in schedule at least 1 session before it runs. Recognized or All Breed are acceptable. \$10 fee per judge required for sponsoring class to be added. Class fees are in addition. Anyone else may enter at the normal class fee for that division once added at normal class fee. Added

classes will be on the Facebook page and also at the office. TBA classes may be entered with the class number in the schedule where they can run as available, with that schedule position picked by Sponsor.

Certifications -For all breed recognized classes, Youth and amateur memberships, eligibility designations and relationship to Owner must be filled out on entry form. Birthdates are required for all amateur and youth exhibitors.

Age Divisions/Eligibility: No memberships required to participate. AHANM Membership is encouraged for you circuit points to count for year-end awards. Age division must be declared on entry form. Rider may enter one horse per event. Only one run per event per horse

Lead Line: ages 6/Under with adult handler. Walk/trot only. 5 second penalty for 4th lope stride/occurrence

Pee-Wee: Ages 8 & Under (No assistance)

Junior: Ages 9-13

Senior: Ages 14-18

Events will have a limits! Acceptance determined by order or entries received. Pre-entry recommended!

Timing: All runs must be timed utilizing electronic eyes. Missed times must be offered a re-run.

Ground: Every effort should be made to provide safe and even ground for all contestants. The ground should be worked at regular intervals (at least every 5 runs).

Pole Bending: Poles to be spaced 21' apart with 6b poles total. Pattern is standard pole bending pattern.

Flag Race: Flag placed at 3rd barrel marker.

Barrel Pattern.: The location of each barrel and the timer must be staked or otherwise marked to ensure the proper placement of the barrels. The exact dimensions of the barrel pattern will depend on the dimensions of the facility.

Payback: 80% of entry fees. The number of places paid and the payoff percentages for each place are left to the discretion of Management based on entries. Adult W9 required for payout to be issued.

Prizes: Each event will offer placings through 6th place for each age division with ribbons.

Exceptional Horse Show Rules



Eligibility to Compete: Exhibitors must have a physical and or cognitive disability to participate in any of the above classes.

Membership: This a “play day” event with no national points or organization recognitions. No membership is required. The Arabian Horse Association of New Mexico, (AHANM will count the points earned in this show to go towards year-end high point awards for AHANM members. Visit www.NMArabs.org for optional membership and year-end additional eligibility.

Prizes: Every exhibitor will get a ribbon for all the places 1st-6th in every class. Additional sponsored prizes may be available and posted a the show.

Entry Fees: Each EXHIBITOR pays a one-time office base fee and their classes. This office fee covers parking and admission for exhibitor for 1 vehicle. Each class is \$10 in addition to the office base fee. Horse stall/tackrooms fees will need to be added or paid by Trainer per horse or added to an exhibitor entry.

Safety/Conduct: This show will follow the general practices for safety and rules for similar Special Olympic events. All Exhibitors must wear helmets, boots and long-sleeve shirt with jeans. Supported Exhibitors may have as many handlers as needed for safety.

Speed Event Penalties:

If you break into the next gait you will receive a 5 second penalty for every 3 steps. You are given 3 strides to correct without a penalty. For example is you are signed up for a walk class you must walk and not break into a trot. If you are in a trot class you must trot and not break into a lope. If gait is broken continuously throughout pattern you will be disqualified. 3 gait penalties will incur a “No Time.”

LEVEL RULES: Each Exhibitor must declare a single division on entry form. Each Exhibitor competes in eligible classes only one level. Please choose the most appropriate division for exhibitor’s safety. Exhibitors must be entered in classes that correspond to their abilities. You may ONLY ENTER one Halter, one Stock Seat, one Trail, one Barrel and one Pole class.

E - In Hand Only. Exhibitor fully controls and handles horse with allowed assistance from Handlers for safety. No cross entry with any mounted classes to compete in this division.

D - Walk Only. Horse handler uses attached lead rope to control horse. Handler gives instruction and physical assistance to Exhibitor as needed. Exhibitor may also have side walkers.

C - Walk Only. Can be attached or unattached. If horse handler is attached to lead rope it is for safety only. Exhibitor independently maneuvers horse without verbal or physical assistance from handler. May have handler and side walkers. Exhibitor is 100% in charge of horse, not handler.

B - Trot. Can be attached or unattached. If horse handler is attached to lead rope it is for safety only. Exhibitor independently maneuvers horse without verbal or physical assistance from handler. May have handler and side walkers. Exhibitor is 100% in charge of horse, not handler.

A - Lope - No handler or assistants in the arena with Exhibitor. Exhibitor is completely independent.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of New Mexico AHANM, dba Expo NM (“Expo”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in both sanctioned/non-sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities of the Equine Events (“Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (“Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of Expo as published in the Premium Book and on the website at www.statefair.exponm.com, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).
