Schedule:

Dressage- Covered Arena- 8:00am start

Ride times will be emailed out and posted on Horse Spot after entries close.

Small ring tests will start. Large ring tests will follow.

Stadium- Outdoor arena- Approx 10:00am start

Fence heights high to low, ride times will be assigned. Extra stadium rounds available after each division is finished. Pre entry of extra stadium round is encouraged if you think you will want to do it for scheduling purposes. No penalty for scratching day of.



SERIES PRIZES

Champion and Reserve winter series prizes will be awarded in each CT division and for USDF/WDAA tests

Horse/rider must compete in at least 2 of the 3 shows to qualify.

Winners will be awarded based on the average of their 2 best finishing scores (CT) or 2 best dressage scores (individual dressage rides)

Champion will be awarded a ribbon and Remarkable Leather Goods prize. Reserve will be awarded a ribbon.

ENTRIES: Entries may be submitted on spellbound.horsespot.net or emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com. CT/Dressage entries are due the Monday prior to the show, late entries may be accepted if space allows. **Payment will be taken day of show**

Exhibitors must check in at the show office. No numbers will be issued without a signed liability release and an open check or full payment. **No credit/debit card payment will be accepted.**

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. Coggins may be uploaded to Horse Spot with entry or emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com. Non-showing horses must also be entered and submit coggins.

Warm-up Areas: Fenced grass paddocks

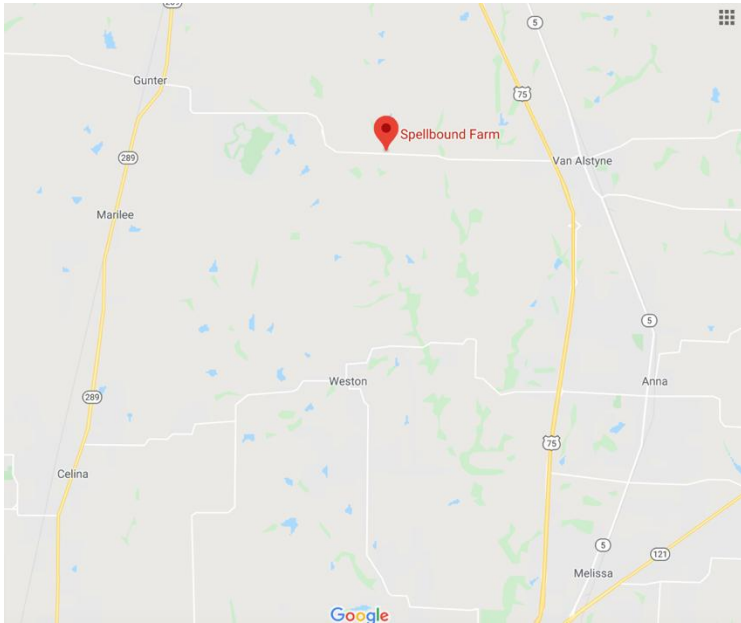
****WEATHER:** Please note, we are a private facility, not an all weather show facility. Show may be canceled or postponed due to excessive rain or bad weather.
