ENTRIES: Entries may be submitted on spellbound.horsespot.net or emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com. CT/Dressage entries are due October 3rd, late entries may be accepted if space allows. Sunday jumper only entries are due October 7th. Same day adds of jumper rounds are allowed if time permits.

Exhibitors must check in at the show office. No numbers will be issued without a signed liability release and an open check or full payment. No credit/debit card payment will be accepted.

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Includes non-showing entries.

SCHOOLING: Friday- Ticketed Schooling in the dressage arena and over the jump course. Saturday Morning- Open schooling in both arenas from 6:30-7:30am Saturday Evening- Ticketed jumper schooling after combined test is finished Sunday Morning- Schooling in the covered arena from 6:30-7:15am

ARENAS: Covered arena: 135x250 covered arena with custom Kiser footing and fans

Outdoor arena: 100x200 with sand footing Warm-up Areas: Fenced grass paddocks

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or otherwise confined.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.
