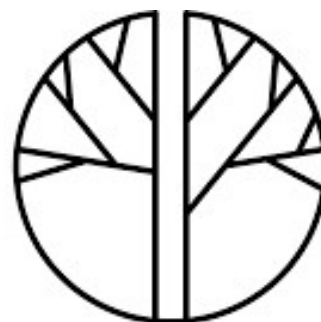

ENTRIES: Entries may be submitted on spellbound.horsespot.net or emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com. Entries are due by August 22nd, late entries may be accepted if space allows. Same day adds of jumper rounds are allowed if time permits.

Dressage/CT entries may close earlier if entry cap is reached (max 40 tests).

Exhibitors must check in at the show office. No numbers will be issued without a signed liability release and an open check or full payment. **No credit/debit card payment will be accepted.**

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Includes non-showing entries.

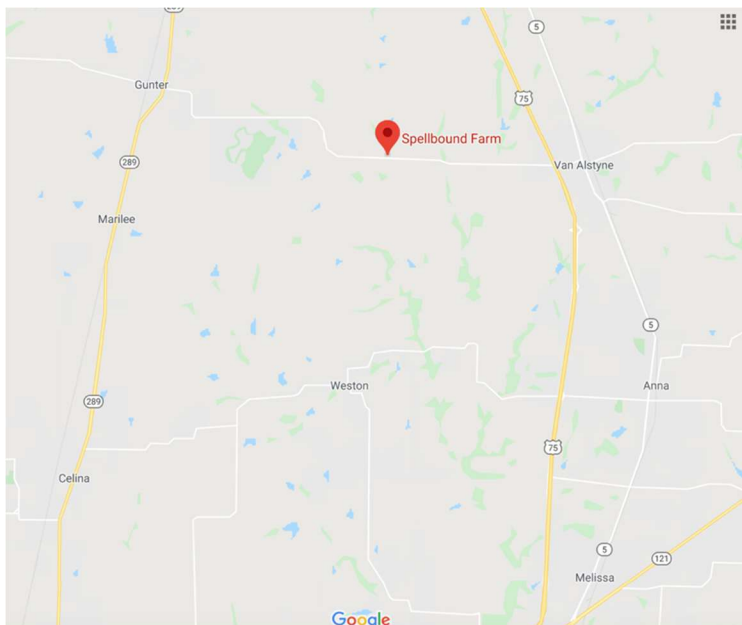
SCHOOLING: Friday- Dressage arena in the covered arena, schooling fences in the outdoor.
Saturday Morning- Schooling in the covered arena from 6:30-7:30am
Saturday Evening- Ticketed jumper schooling from 6:00-7:30pm
Sunday Morning- Schooling in the covered arena from 6:30-7:15am

ARENAS: Show arena: 135x250 covered arena with custom Kiser footing and fans
Warm-up Arena: 100x200 with sand footing

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or otherwise confined.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.
