

AEE Fall Online Horse Show

Show Details

- Entries Open September 23rd and Close October 18th
- Entries will be judged after closing and results provided no later than November 5, 2025
- · All riders may receive feedback on their ride as well as a score for the round. The top 6 riders from each class will receive beautiful ribbons mailed to their homes. First place will receive prizes along with their ribbons.
- · Eligible to all Alumni Equestrian Events (AEE) members.

- · Riders may enter any combination of classes or all classes
- · Class Fee: \$35 per class (plus processing fee)
- All class fees must be paid in full before the close of entries to be included in judging. Entries should be submitted and paid for using Horse Spot; https://aee.horsespot.net/shows. Please input your College Name as your horse's name.
- · Riders must upload videos to YouTube (with either public or unlisted permissions we can't see private) and email your entry to alumnieqevents@gmail.com. Include your name, class and written course (for hunt seat fences).
- · Any riders whose AEE Zone has had limited ability to host shows, this will allow you to utilize your membership and gain points towards Zones.
- Management reserves the right to cancel the class if at least 3 entries are not received to judge. All monies paid will be returned in full if classes are canceled.
- Management reserves the right to split classes if there are more than 10 entries.
- Show clothing is not required but a neat clean appearance is highly recommended.

Hunt Seat Classes

The horse show will offer one over fences class and one flat class.

- Alumni Flat Riders must submit a video no longer than 2.5 minutes long that showcases their equitation abilities at the following gates in both directions: Walk, Trot, Sitting Trot and Canter. Riders to be judged on basic position, position in motion, effectiveness of aids with the horse. A neat appearance is highly suggested but show clothing is not required. Videos should be from January 1, 2025 up until the entry submission deadline.
- Alumni Fences Riders must submit a video no longer than 2 minutes long of an over fences equitation course that includes the following requirements.
 - At least 6 and no more than 8 jumping elements
 - At least two changes of direction
 - Fences must be at least 2' in height and no higher than 2'6" in height

Riders will be judged on the suitability of the course (your winning jumper round or hunter round might not be the best submission), effectiveness of the rider and position in motion. You may submit videos of courses from competitive events or lessons. Videos should be of courses that occurred Jan 1, 2025 up until the entry submission deadline.

Western Classes

The horse show will offer one horsemanship class, one reining class and one ranch class.

- Alumni Horsemanship Pattern Riders must submit a video no longer than 2.5 minutes long of a horsemanship pattern completed since January 1, 2025 to present. Riders must use IHSA Level 1 Pattern A
- Alumni Ranch Riding Riders must submit a video no longer than 2.5 minutes long
 of a ranch pattern completed since January 1, 2025 to present. Riders must use <u>AQHA</u>
