FEDERATION STATEMENTS

UNITED STATES EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule:

1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of The Brave Horse Show Series (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

USEF Waiver

Everyone, including parents, grooms, guests, etc. must sign a USEF Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement, this can be done on Horsespot.net at the time you do your entries. Forms are available at www.horseshowing.com or www.usef.org.

Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Statement as to Federation Fee

(GR407.1-3) For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee.

Health Requirements

All horses must have a valid proof of a negative equine infectious anemia test within the past 12 months. (Coggins test). A 30-day certificate of veterinary inspection is required for all horses arriving from outside the state of Pennsylvania.

1. At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the



- following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
- 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
- 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
- 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
- 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

THIS WILL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY TO THIS SHOW OR SHOW GROUNDS.

Safe Sport Statement

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirements to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

As of Jan 1, 2019 every USEF adult member (18 years of age or older) with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training. You will do this when logged into your USEF account, preferably when you renew your membership. Failure to complete the safe sport training will disqualify you from competing in any capacity until it is completed. Junior riders that have reached their 18th Birthday must complete the Safe Sport.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- UILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom, shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. All exhibitors must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted on the show grounds. All dogs must be on leashes and under owner's control. All Hunter and Equitation classes will receive ribbons through eighth place. All sections with three or more classes will receive champion and reserve Awards. Jumper Awards follow USEF JP110. Sharps and Medical waste must be disposed of in sharps container available in the barns. Management reserves the right to use a dotted line in any hunter or equitation class. Ties involving first place in the jumpers will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided upon time unless otherwise stated. A starting orde
- 2. SCHOOLING RULES: All entries Must have back number to participate in schooling. Open schooling in main and bridge hunter rings up to 30 min before the start of the ring. Ticketed schooling times will be posted on the schedule. \$30 Ticketed Schooling will be available. Additional afternoon sessions may be added and will be announced, time permitting. Management has the right to cancel due to time restrictions or weather. Rings will be open for flatting until approx. ½ hour prior to the start of the first class.
- 3. STABLING: [Swan Lake] Stalls are both permanent and tent stalls with doors. Flooring is either matted (main and cafe barn), stonedust (barn #1, #2, and stonedust barn), or dirt (tent stabling). [McDonogh School] Stalls are temporary 9 x 9 matted stalls with doors.

 Stalls are \$250 per week and are on a first-come first-served basis. All stall requests must be paid for in full and received by the close of entries to secure stalls. STALLS RECEIVED WITHOUT PAYMENT WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED. There is a \$50 non-refundable deposit on each stall. All horses staying in stalls will be charged a stall fee. ONLY horses under the same ownership are able to share stalls. Feed and bedding are available from our feed office. Horses staying in stalls will not be charged a grounds fee. No refunds on stalls after the closing date of entries. No Electric Golf Carts. All extension cords used in the barns must be a minimum of 14'.
- **4. CAMPER SPACES:** Camper spaces must be reserved on your entry or with the office shows@swanlakestables.com or 717-873-1222. All campers \$275 (50 amp) and \$225 (30 amp) Camper Fee per week. [Mid Atlantic Autumn Classic at Swan Lake Stables Only]
- 5. ENTRIES: Entries must be received the day before showing. ONLINE entries only! No phone, faxed, mailed or emailed entries will be accepted. Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of there agents in preparation of their entry forms. You can enter online at www.horsespot.net. A credit card is required to be submitted with each online entry. AN OPEN CHECK OR CREDIT CARD, VALID COGGINS TEST, PROOF OF EHV-1 VACCINATION AND ALL APPLICABLE MEMBERSHIP AND MEASUREMENT CARDS ARE REQUIRED TO BE PRESENTED TO THE OFFICE BEFORE NUMBERS MAY BE PICKED



- UP. An office fee of \$75 will be assessed all entries. All accounts must be settled on Sunday of the end of the competition. A processing fee of \$100 plus collection fees will be charged for all non-negotiable checks.
- 6. NON-SHOWING HORSES: All horses on the show grounds must be registered in the office and show negative Coggins and proof of EHV 1/4. Non-showing horses with stalls will be charged a \$100 Non-Showing horse fee in addition to stall fees and office fee. Non-showing horses without stalls will be charged a \$160 Non-Showing fee plus a grounds fee.
- 7. SCRATCHES: Horses scratched before the closing date of entries will receive full repayment of fees minus a \$75 office fee. Stalls will be refunded minus the \$50 deposit if scratched before the closing date of entries. Stalls will not be refunded after the start of the horse show. Horses scratched after the closing date will be responsible for a \$25 scratch fee plus office fee.
- **8. FOOTING:** All footing is sand and fabric.
- 9. RING DIMENSIONS:

- 10. NOMINATING FEE: All horses showing in the 1.20m to 1.40m Jumper Classes, JR/AO sections, Welcome Stake, Mini-Prix must be nominated and pay the nominating fee of \$200 for Mid Atlantic and \$200.00 for Fall Classic by the closing date of entries.
- 11. AWARDS & PRIZE MONEY: Eight ribbons, unless otherwise stated, will be presented in all classes. Champion and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions containing three (3) or more classes with three (3) or more competitors that run to completion. In the Hunter ring, this must include the Under Saddle class if applicable. Prize money will be credited to your bill. Please designate the payee along with mailing address and tax id when entering online. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days of the end of the competition. Three entries, unless otherwise stated, are necessary to fill a class, or the class may be canceled.
- 12. COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins Test within one year is required of every horse entering the show facility.
- 13. MICROCHIPS: All horses that are competing in classes which require USHJA registration which are not microchipped will be ineligible to compete in Federation licensed competitions. A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen-digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.
- 14. EQUINE VACCINATIONS: Per USEF Rule GR845.1 Equine Vaccination Rule: At Federation Licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.
- **15. MANAGEMENT:** The Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split and class if entries warrant or the rules of the USEF require it. Management also reserves the right to change the order of classes or to move classes to another ring. Management reserves the right to decline any entry for any reason and to return money owed before or during the show without being liable for compensation.
- 16. ORDERS OF GO: At management's discretion, classics will have a posted order of go. All Hunter Derbies and Second Round Classics will have a posted order of go.
- 17. CRUELTY TO AND ABUSE OF THE HORSE: Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse present on the grounds of any Licensed Competition is forbidden, constitutes a violation under Chapter 7, and renders the offender subject to penalty. The Show Committee, or Competition Management in the absence of a Show Committee, must bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the competition. It is the duty of the competition officials to report to the Federation any person who indulges in this practice for such further action as may be deemed appropriate. Any action(s) against a horse by a competitor or an exhibitor, which are deemed excessive by a Federation judge, Federation steward, technical delegate or competition veterinarian, in the competition ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the Show Committee. Such action(s) could include but are not limited to excessive use of the whip or spurs. Competitors and exhibitors have the right to contest any action taken pursuant to GR839.5 by filing a protest or grievance pursuant to Chapter 6 of the Rules for hearing and determination by the Hearing Committee. For the purposes of this rule, the term "soring" is defined by the Horse Protection Act, 15 U.S.C. §1821. Any Rider, who in the opinion of the judges, stewards, or schooling supervisors, uses his or her whips or spurs in a cruel of excessive manner will be immediately eliminated from the class in which the incident occurred and may be suspended from further showing for a 24-hour period starting from the time of the incident. In some cases, the rider may be barred from further competition if further violations by that exhibitor take place with the same horse or other horses. All fees owed will be forfeited by that exhibitor with no compensation from the show. All incidents will be reported in the Steward's report and reviewed by USEF's Executive Director for further investigation and charges for hearing b
- 18. POLING & OFFSETS: Manual poling and/or offsets with the use of a bamboo pole or any other device are prohibited at all times. Any rider or trainer found poling or using offsets, as well as the horse or pony involved, will be immediately eliminated from the class where the incident occurred and suspended for a 24-hour period starting from the time of the incident and will forfeit all entry fees. If further violations by the same exhibitor take place on the same horse/pony or another horse/pony, the exhibitor may be barred from further showing and forfeit all fees due to show.

USHJA OUTREACH SPECS

NON-USEF RATED CLASSES - No USEF fees - The USHJA Outreach Program has been established to engage and connect hunter and jumper riders, trainers and horse owners with the USHJA by providing the opportunity to participate in USHJA branded classes and competitions, to earn points toward year-end rewards and awards, and to earn the chance to participate in the prestigious USHJA National Championships. USHJA Outreach Competitions and Classes provide opportunity to earn national recognition in classes from walk/trot to 3'0" in hunter, equitation, and .60m-1.20m in jumper sections at rated and local shows. Any rider may compete in Outreach hunter, jumper, and equitation classes, but riders wishing to earn points and national recognition, must be USHJA free Outreach member or higher. Competitors with a USHJA free Outreach membership or higher will be eligible to earn year-end awards and rewards in hunters, jumpers and equitation. Rewards for competing in any USHJA Outreach Class (Hunter, Equitation, and Jumper) will be based on total points earned. Riders achieving a Bronze, Silver, or Gold point level will be eligible to redeem their points at year-end for items of their choice: USHJA logo wear, Bronze, Silver, or Gold Outreach ribbons or Outreach medallions.

- High point Awards: The highest pointed Gold level rider in each Zone will earn the Golden Back Stage Pass to participate in USHJA National Championship Affiliate Sections, and will be invited to participate in the
- Grand Prix Show Jumping and Hunter Derby course walks, and educational sessions.
- Trainers Awards. Trainers who are USHJA free Outreach members or higher will be awarded points based on their students competing in Outreach classes (student must be a USHJA free Outreach members or higher). One trainer from each Zone whose riders have earned 100 or more points cumulatively, will be recognized as the USHJA Outreach High Point Trainer.
- Horses Awards. Owners of horses competing in Outreach Competitions and Classes wishing to have their horses earn points towards awards must register their horse with USHJA (\$20/year or \$75 lifetime). Horses are not required to be registered with USHJA or microchipped to compete in Outreach classes.

All Hunter Classes are held in accordance with USEF Rules and USHJA Zone 2 Specifications. Management reserves the right to cancel Blue/Red rounds depending on entries. Jogging for soundness, when required, requires each horse to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fence performance. Minimum entry requirements to follow Zone 2 rules. After a horse competes in any rated section requiring a Division Entry Fee, no refunds will be given for scratching classes for any reason.

Hunter prize money will be awarded in accordance with USEF HU127, unless otherwise specified: 30% / 22% / 15% / 12% / 11% / 10%
