Hunter Divisions

Hunter Divisions \$90/Division

Each Hunter Division consists of the following classes:

- Hunter Over Fences classes
- Handy Hunter Over Fences class
- 1 Hunter Undersaddle class.

Child/Junior divisions open to riders 17 and under as of January 1st 2025.

Adult divisions open to riders 18 and older as of January 1st 2025.

Open divisions open to all horses and riders. Horse/Rider combinations may move up or down in height 3" only. Divisions may be combined at managements discretion.

Jumper Divisions

Jumper Divisions

\$90/Division

No oxers for Jumper classes .70m and under. No combinations .85m and under. Child/Junior divisions open to riders 17 and under as of January 1st 2025. Adult divisions open to riders 18 and older as of January 1st 2025. Open divisions open to all horses and riders. Divisions may be combined at management discretion. Horse rider combinations may move up to any height but may not move down more than .10m. 2 refusals results in elimination. Each Jumper Division under .90m consists of a combination of optimum time and immediate jump off. Each Jumper Division .90m and over consists of a combination of optimum time, Speed and immediate jump off.

Speed(.90m and above):

Class consists of up to 10 jumps. To be judged as a speed round with rails down adding 7 seconds on to the horse and riders time score. A time allowed will be posted with a time fault given for every 2 seconds over the time allowed.

Optimum Time:

Class consists of up to 10 jumps. Optimum time should be four (4) seconds less than the time allowed. The course designer will calculate the optimum time based on the

posted speed. Horse and rider are to try to get as close to the time as possible. Faults to be calculated based on Table A

Immediate Jump Off

Round 1 to consist of up to 10 jumps. A time allowed will be posted with a time fault given for every 2 seconds over the time allowed. 4 faults given to every rail down or refusal. Horses and riders that are clear in round 1 advance to the jump off. The fastest time with the least faults wins the class.

Points will be given for all 3 classes in the division to determine the champion.

Specialty Classes

Country Lane Medal

Entry \$45

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a hunter type course with 8 or more obstacles at heights of 2'9 and 3'. To qualify for finals each rider must have placed in any class throughout the Platinum series at Country Lane Farm or Southlands riding club. Finals will take place at the Country Lane Classic. Winner of the medal final may not compete in the finals again. Competitors may only compete in either the mini medal or medal but not both.

Country Lane Mini Medal

Entry \$45

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a hunter type course with 8 or more obstacles at heights of 2'3 and 2'6. To qualify for finals each rider must have placed in any class throughout the Platinum series at Country Lane Farm or Southlands riding club. Finals will take place at the Country Lane Classic. Winner of the mini medal final may not compete in the mini medal finals again. Competitors may only compete in either the mini medal or medal but not both.

Southlands Mini Medal

Entry \$45

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a Jumper type course with 8 or more obstacles at heights of .75m .85m . To qualify for finals each rider must have placed in any class throughout the Platinum series at Country Lane Farm or Southlands riding club. Finals will take place at Southlands. Winner of the medal final may not compete in the mini medal finals again. Competitors may only compete in either the mini medal or medal but not both.

Southlands Medal

Entry \$45

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a Jumper type course with 8 or more obstacles at heights of .90m, 1.0m . To qualify for finals each rider must have placed in any class throughout the Platinum series at Country Lane Farm or Southlands riding club. Finals will take place at Southlands. Winner of the medal final may not compete in the mini medal or medal finals again. Competitors may only compete in either the mini medal or medal but not both.

Hunter Derby

Entry \$60

Open to all horses and riders. One round format. To follow the Canadian Hunter Derby rules. To be judged as a handy round with unique turns and approaches, inside turns slices, athleticism, boldness and impressive start and finish. Scores will be given for base score out of 100, 2 points for each high option jumped, 10 total handy points awarded. High options will be 3 inches higher than the height set. Heights include 2'3, 2'6, 2'9, 3', 3'3. Ribbons to 8th, Prize money to 5th.

Mini Prix

Entry \$60

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a jumper course with 8 or more obstacles in round 1 with an immediate jump off to riders with a clear first round. Heights offered at .75m, .85m, .90m 1.0m . A time allowed will be posted with a time fault given for every 2 seconds over the time allowed. 4 faults given to every rail down or refusal. Horses and riders that are clear in round 1 advance to the immediate jump off. The fastest time with the least faults wins the class. Ribbons to 8th, Prize money to 5th.

All horses must have a number.
All riders must have Horse Council of BC and signed a waiver prior to receiving their number.
Lunging may take place in designated lunging areas.

Class Add

Classes may be entered at anytime with no additional charge.

Refunds

Stall reservation refunds will be given up to the Thursday prior to the show, stall cancellations after that time will only be refunded if your stall is filled. All other refunds will be given at anytime.

Tack

No Tack restrictions in classes. Hunter tack recommended for hunter, hunter derby and equitation classes.

Attire

All riders must wear a number. ASTM approved helmets and appropriate footwear must be worn. Braiding and show jackets are optional.

Show Office

The show office will be open 1 hour prior to the start of each show on show days and from 12:00pm to 5:00pm on warm up day. All competitors are to check out at the office once finished their classes for the show and settle their account.

Vaccines

All horses must be vaccinated within 6 months of attending shows.

Smoking

There is no smoking on the property

Dogs

Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your dog.

Concession

Food Trucks available on site each show day

Dangerous conduct or horse abuse

Management reserves the right to excuse a competitor for horse abuse or dangerous conduct on or off their horse.

Show Entry Closing dates

Show Entries close at 5:00pm on the Thursday prior to the show. Please email show management if you wish to enter after the closing date.

Ribbons to 6th. All prizes must be picked up by 8pm on Sunday of each show
