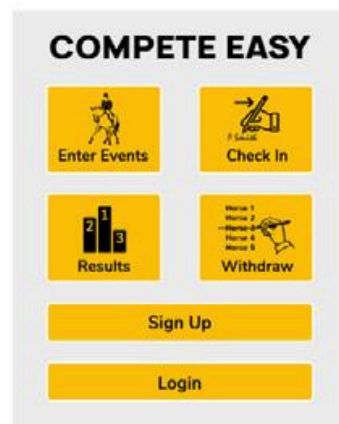

AWARDS

OVERALL HIGHSORE

Awarded to the horse and rider combination with the lowest final score across all phases.

JUNIOR DRESSAGE HIGHSORE

Awarded to the junior rider (18 years of age or younger) with the lowest dressage score.

SENIOR DRESSAGE HIGHSORE

Awarded to the senior rider (19 years of age or older) with the lowest dressage score.

A/B PONY CLUBBER HIGHSORE

Awarded to the A or B level Pony Club member with the lowest final score across all phases.

C/D PONY CLUBBER HIGHSORE

Awarded to the C or D level Pony Club member with the lowest final score across all phases.

RIDE OF THE DAY

Awarded on all competition days to the rider who had the most notable ride that day - good or bad.



DRESSAGE

- Dressage tests will take place on the Saturday of each show, beginning with Starter tests.
- Starter level will ride 2023 EC EV 85 Test 1
- Pre-Entry will ride 2023 EC EV 85 Test 2
- Entry/Pre-Training will ride 2023 EC EV 85 Test 2.
- All tests will be ridden in a small (20' by 40') outdoor arena.
- Tests may be called at all levels.



STADIUM

- Stadium rounds will take place on the Saturday of each show, beginning with Starter rounds.
- Stadium rounds will be run open gate: upon completion of the dressage test, rider may complete their stadium round at any time within the window for their level.
- The course will be open to walk as of 5:00pm on the Friday evenings, and can also be walked any time on the Saturdays when the ring is empty (at the discretion of the stadium judge).
- Starter: Cross rails or 2'3"
- Pre-Entry: Up to 2'6"
- Entry/Pre-Training: 2'9" or 3'0"
- Riders must indicate height choice on entry form. Riders will not be separated, penalized, or rewarded for height choice.
- Divisions will only be split by stadium height category if numbers warrant.



CROSS COUNTRY

- Cross Country rounds will take place on the Sunday of both shows, beginning with Entry/Pre-Training rounds.
- Starter: Max 2'0" jump height, approximately 1,200m long at 325m/minute.
- Pre-Entry: Max 2'6" jump height, approximately 1,500m long at 375m/minute.
- Entry/Pre-Training: Max 2'9" jump height with some 3'0" Pre-Training options and a ditch. Approximately 1,700m long at 375m/minute.
- Terrain is mostly flat, and some portions of the course will be on hog fuel track and sand.
- Course will be open for walking as of 6:30pm on the Friday of both shows, though please note that numbering and jump placement may still be in progress at this time.



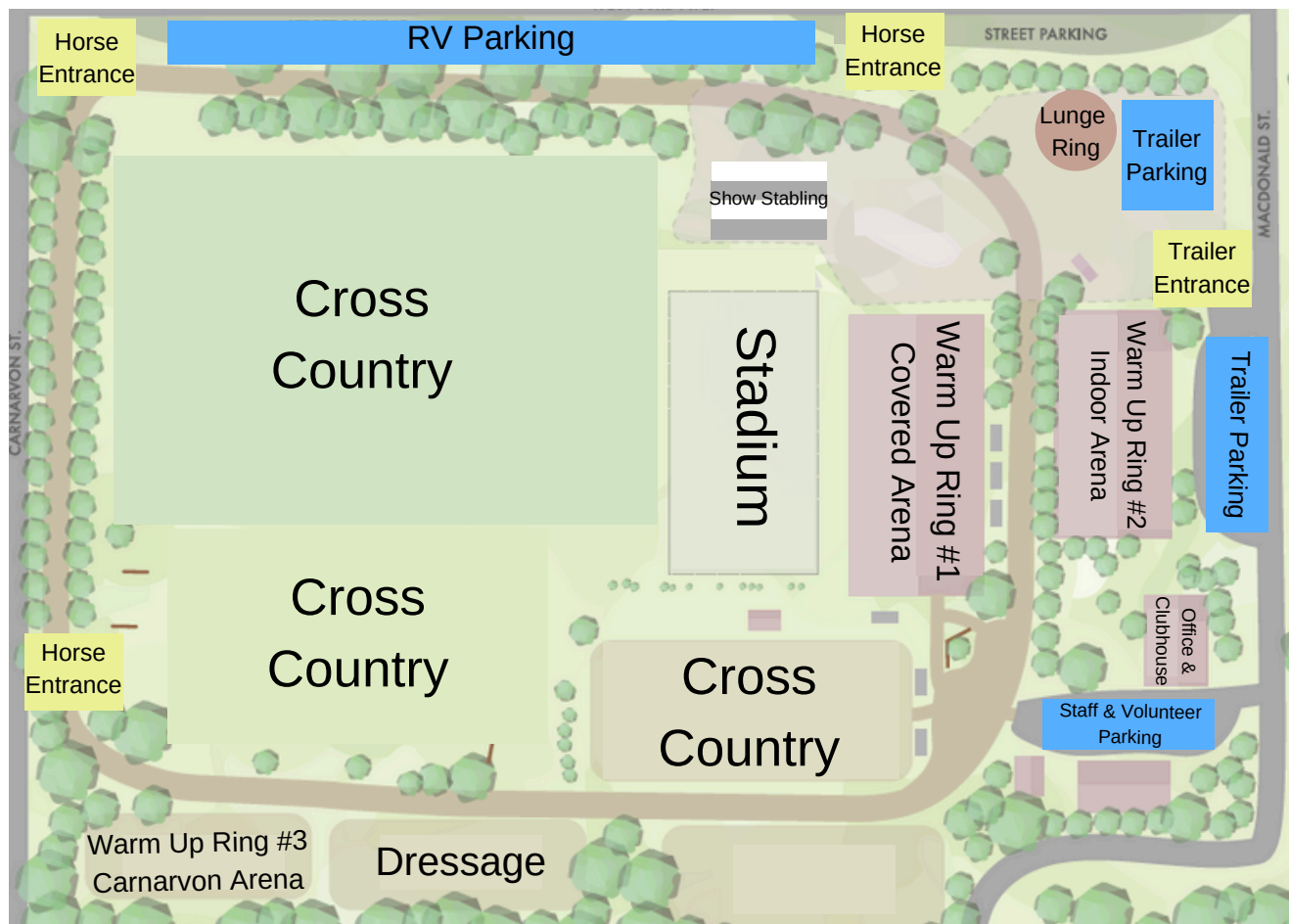
GENERAL INFORMATION

Move-in and Move-out Reminders

- Horse trailers and other vehicles are to enter and exit the property using the gates located along 53rd Ave (see yellow circles above) OR Macdonald St (beside indoor arena).
- RV's and trailers with electrical hook-up bookings are to enter the property from the gate near Carnarvon on 53rd Ave and proceed east along the track to their designated spot; please park on an angle as indicated; exit from gate closest to the indoor ring when leaving the show.
- Trailers remaining on-site for the duration of show may park between the track and the fence line along 53rd Ave (signage and volunteers will provide directions).
- Once unloaded, please park all vehicles outside of the property; parking for vehicles is available to the east of the Covered Arena (semi-circular drive), along 53rd Ave (south side of street) and Macdonald St (east side; north of 53rd)
- Clubhouse parking lot is for show staff and volunteers only.

Food and Beverages

- The licensed Clubhouse has hot and cold beverages - including espresso beverages, wine and beer, snacks and light fare (pre-packaged, sandwiches, salads, etc.) available for purchase during Show Office hours.



RULES & REGULATIONS

ENTRIES

- Entry Fee: \$150.00 plus GST for all divisions
- Entries can be made online only through Compete Easy
- All payments must be made in full prior to the event

STABLING

- Stabling Fee: \$115.00 plus GST for the weekend
 - Overnight stalls include 3 bags of shavings
- Day Stabling Fee: \$50.00 per day
 - Day stalls include 1 bag of shavings
- Tack Stall Fee: \$75.00 plus GST for the weekend
- Clean Stall Deposit: \$50.00
 - Will be returned if stall is left clean upon leaving the show

ACCOMODATION

- FREE camping is available
- RV parking with electric hookup available for \$125.00
- RV and trailer parking (no electric hookup) is available in the parking lot next to the indoor arena for free

REFUNDS

- After the closing date:
 - With a vet certificate, 50% of entry and stabling fees will be refunded
 - Without a vet certificate, no refunds will be offered
- Before the closing date:
 - All fees will be refunded except the \$50 administration fee

ADDITIONAL FEES

- Administration Fee: \$50.00
- Medic Fee: \$20.75
- Post-Entry Fee: \$45.00

RULES & REGULATIONS

PARKING

- Trailer entrance is next to indoor arena off of Macdonald Street
- Trailers may be unloaded and left on the North side of the indoor arena but must be unhooked and parked as instructed
- All vehicles must be parked outside of Club perimeter fencing

PRIZES

- Ribbons awarded from 1st through 8th place
- Prizes awarded from 1st through 3rd place
- Starter and Pre-Entry divisions will be split into Junior and Senior divisions



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
