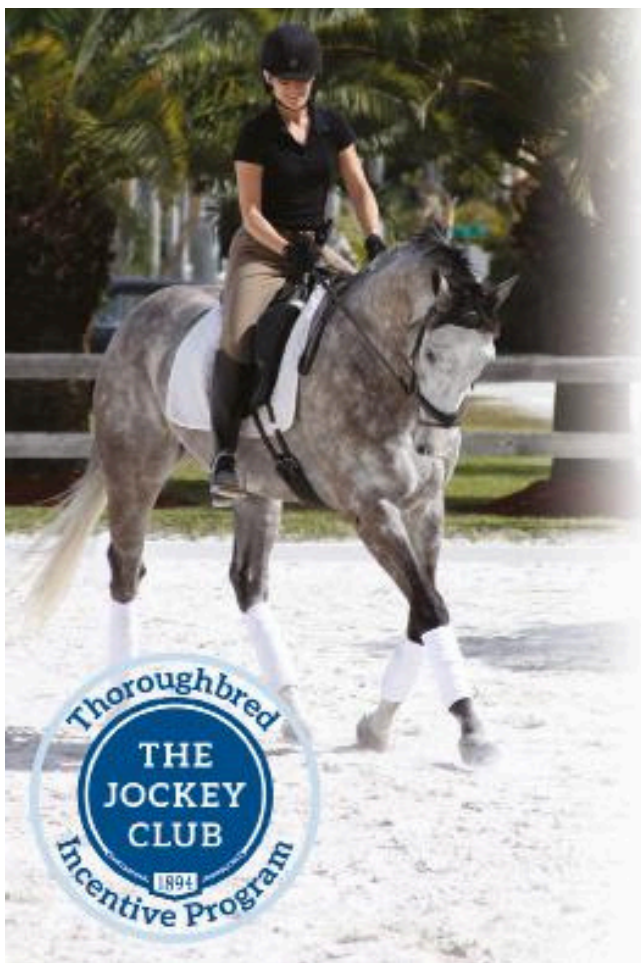

RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL

1. **This Competition is a Horse Council BC provincially sanctioned Competition** and will be governed in accordance with the Horse Council BC Rule Book. Knowledge of the Rules is the responsibility of the Competitor. The Horse Council Rule book can be found here - <https://hcbc.ca/competitions/hcbc-rule-book/>. Neither Horse Council BC, it's Board of Directors, organizing committee, staff, volunteers, officials or employees of this horse show, will be responsible in any way, for damage, injury or loss to persons, horses or property of exhibitors, spectators, owners, riders, trainers or grooms. All competitors and owners of horses must be members of Horse Council BC to participate.
2. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules & specifications of the current rules of HCBC. **Classes will use 2023 EC National tests.** Only EC, WDAA (Western Dressage)/HCBC Western and USDF Freestyle will be used.
3. **Safety headgear** - All riders, regardless of age or level or competition must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any sanctioned dressage competition at the event location.
4. **Ring Size** - All tests will be held in a 20 x 60 ring. Warm up rings are 20x60. Rings and ride-times will be available 2 days prior to the show, depending on the number of changes and requests required.
5. Neither Southlands Riding Club (SRC) nor the Dressage Committee shall be held responsible in any way for damage, injury or loss to persons, horses or property of spectators, owners, riders or grooms.
6. Riders and owners must be HCBC members.
7. Whips may be carried in all tests to a maximum length of 120cm (including lash) and Ponies 100cm maximum length (including lash). Lunge whips are only permitted when lunging in designated area.
8. Lunging is only permitted in the lunge ring located north of the Indoor Ring. Helmets must be worn while lunging.
9. Callers are allowed in EC National level tests. Competitors must provide their own callers.
10. Legboots and bandage are allowed in all classes.
11. The horse competition number must be worn at all times while outside of stall on SRC property.
12. Dogs must be leashed and under control at all times, if found off leash owners are subject to a \$50 fine. All dog owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
13. Hors concours rides are allowed at the discretion of SRC Management. See entry rules.
14. With a veterinarian's certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. There will be a \$25 substitution fee and all monies will be transferred to the new horse.

RULES & REGULATIONS

15. Biosecurity - Southlands Riding Club is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all exhibitors and their horses. All horses are required to have a BioSecurity form submitted to the show office prior to receiving their competition number. All competitors are requested to practice good disease prevention practices. Travelling and showing horses are at an increased risk for contracting and spreading contagious diseases. All horses entering the show grounds must not have been in contact with any sick horses within the last 15 days. Any horse that has been sick or exposed to an infectious disease within the last 15 days must have their attending veterinarian contract the Southlands Riding Club veterinarian prior to entering the show grounds. We ask that any horse with a rectal temperature above 38.5C (101.8F) be reported to show management and/or show veterinarian immediately. The show veterinarian will examine any horses with an elevated temperature or other signs of illness prior to being allowed to show. Any horse identified to have or is suspected of having a contagious disease will be removed to the isolation area.

ENTRIES

- Entries close on SATURDAY PRIOR TO THE SHOW AT MIDNIGHT. Entries received after closing date are subject to post-entry fees.
- One horse/rider per entry form.
- Entries must be completed online at horsespot.net. If you need assistance, please contact Reagan at events@southlandsridingclub.com
- All competitors must sign a waiver. All RIDERS must be current members of HCBC. Foreign competitors must be members of their National Equestrian Federation.
- Numbers will NOT be given to competitors who have outstanding balances for their show entries. When picking up numbers, competitors are required to pay for outstanding amounts (ie, miscalculations, NSF cheque replacement and fee, post entry fee, missing photocopies).
- SRC Management will try to contact any competitor who has an outstanding balance prior to the start of the show. Entry confirmations will be emailed to all competitors verifying each entry accepted and confirmed. Any change in an entry after closing date will be charged \$20 per change.
- SRC management reserve the right to limit the number of entries and/or refuse any entry; split, cancel or combine and/or adjust classes or award; govern all conditions of the show and make decisions upon any matters not covered by HCBC rules.
- Ride times will be sent out 2 days before the start of the show.
- The show will try to accommodate each horse rider combination as best as possible to allow for suitable warm up time for all tests a rider has entered. A minimum of 30 minutes between start of ride times will be scheduled it and where possible. In cases where this is not feasible in the ride schedule, affected riders will be given the option of accepting the available ride time or being remove from the class and refunded the class fee.

RULES & REGULATIONS

CLASS RULES

- Classes may be scheduled at any time on the day listed in the class schedule. Ride times will only be changed in the case of error, overlapping times or to facilitate the running of the show.
- Each horse is limited to a **maximum of four (4) tests per day in Training and First Level and a maximum of three (3) tests per day for Second Level and higher.**
- **Scratches must notify the Show office.**
- **Only one Test of Choice per class may be entered in all Test of Choice (ToC) classes.** ToC classes are awarded on total percentages of all tests.
- Classes will be split (JR/AA/O).
- Freestyle Class - Music will be accepted as MP3/MP4. Music must be provided to the Show office in the morning of the show before lunch break. Sound check will take place during the lunch break. The time will be emailed to all freestyle competitors.
- If you are under 19, the March and April shows are BC Summer Games qualifiers including freestyle classes. Declaration for the BC Summer Games can be found on the HCBC website.
- The March and April shows are both qualifiers for the BC Senior Games.
- All Prix Caprilli classes will use 2016 Prix Caprilli Test 1 from HCBC.

REFUNDS/POST ENTRIES

- Refunds
 - CANCELLATION BEFORE CLOSING DATE - all fees refunded except of the administration fee
- CANCELLATION AFTER CLOSING DATE BUT BEFORE THE START OF THE HORSE SHOW
 - 50% of class fees will be refunded
 - 100% of stabling fee will be refunded; administration fees will not be refunded
- CANCELLATION AFTER THE START OF THE SHOW
 - No refund
- Post entry fees of \$20 per entry will be added to any entries received after the closing date. Post entries will only be accepted, if space is available
- Entries received prior to the closing date, after the competition is full, will be put on a wait list. They will NOT be subject to post entry fees if/when they are accepted into the show. If the competitor does not wish to be on a waiting list or does not get into the show, all entry fees will be refunded.

RULES & REGULATIONS

STABLING

- Limited portable stabling will be available on the show grounds. Stalls will be available on the day prior to the event until two hours following the end of the event. Payment of stalls must accompany entries and is not refundable once stalls are assigned. Day stays are available at \$50 plus GST (including 2 bags of shavings) with overnight stalls being available at \$75 per night plus with 3 bags of shavings.
- To ensure stabling as a group, please state with whom you wish to be stabled with on your entry form.
- Additional shavings will be available to purchase for \$12.50 a bag plus GST
- Clean out deposit - \$50 includes GST stall clean out deposit is required for all stabled horses. This deposit will be charged and then refunded if the competitor cleans their stall and informs the office prior to leaving the show.
- A stall chart will be posted in the stabling areas. Please note that stabling is assigned and any changes must be approved by SRC Management.

TRAILER & RV PARKING

- Trailer parking is on a first come first serve basis and trailers must park in designated locations only.
- Horse trailers can be parked in the street parking area along 53rd (on the South side of the street) or in the gravel area immediately East of the show stabling (limited space available, angle parking only). If you require staff assistance or directions, please contact the SRC office upon arrival (604-263-4817). Once unloaded, please park all vehicles outside of the show grounds.
- Parking for vehicles is available along 53rd Avenue (south side of the street) and Macdonald Street (east side; north of 53rd).
- Tent camping and limited RV electric hook ups available for free. Please inquire at the SRC office.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE AT SOUTHLANDS

- Vehicles are to enter and exit the property using the gate located just North of the Indoor Ring on Macdonald Street (See map)
- The Clubhouse parking lot is for staff and volunteers only.

FOR SAFETY REASONS AND CONSIDERATION OF YOUR FELLOW COMPETITORS

- **TRAILER ACCESS TO THE STABLING AREA WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THE FOLLOWING TIMES:**
 - **WARM UP DAY - ALL DAY ACCESS**
 - **COMPETITION DAYS: PRIOR TO 7:30AM, DURING LUNCH BREAK AND AFTER THE COMPETITION OF THE SHOW**

RULES & REGULATIONS

The competitor agrees that those images and recordings are the sole and exclusive property of SRC and hereby consent to SRC's release and reproduction of all photographic and video images, recordings and likenesses taken during its events for future promotional or commercial purposes, without any notice or compensation to the competitor.

OFFICE HOURS

- Regular hours - Monday to Saturday - 9am to 5pm
- Show hours - the office is open 1 hour before the first scheduled ride time and closed one hour after the last class of the day.
