Awards



Ride of The Day

Awarded at the end of each day for every show.

Hunter of the Year

Awarded at the end of the season at the SRC Spring Classic.

Jumper of the Year

Awarded at the end of the season at the SRC Spring Classic.

Hunter Derby Award

Awarded at the end of the season at the SRC Spring Classic to the horse with the most points throughout the platinum series.

Mini Prix Award

Awarded at the end of the season at the SRC Spring Classic to the horse with the most points throughout the platinum series.

SRC Medal Award

Awarded to the winner of the Country Lane Medal final at the SRC Spring Classic.

Year End Division Awards

Awarded to the high point horse and rider combination throughout the platinum series in the following divisions:

Hunters: Trot poles, Cross Rails, 2' Jr/Am, 2'3" Short Stirrup, 2'3" Long Stirrup, 2'6" Pre-Child, 2'6" Pre Adult, 2'9" Modified Child, 2'9" Modified Adult, 3'0" Children's Hunter, and 3'0" Adult Amateur Hunter

Jumpers: Jr/Am 0.65m, Jr/Am 0.70m, Jr/Am 0.75m, Jr/Am 0.85m, Jr/Am 0.90m, and Jr/Am 1.00m

Hunter Classes



Hunter Divisions: \$90/Division

Child/Junior divisions open to riders 17 and under. Adult Amateur divisions open to riders 18 and older who are amateur riders. Open divisions open to all horses and riders. Year end points awarded to Juniors and Amateurs only. Divisions may be combined at managements discretion. Each Hunter Division consists of the following classes:

Hunter Over Fences:

Horse and rider to be judged on style, manners, and performance while jumping a course of 8 fences. The horse should display a steady rhythm, good form over fences, correct striding, and smooth, balanced turns. Riders are expected to guide their horses with quiet, effective aids, maintaining a consistent pace throughout the course.

Handy Hunter Over Fences:

Tests all the same qualities as a regular hunter class - style, manners, and quality of movement over a course of jumps - but adds elements that showcase a horse's handiness, or ability to navigate more challenging tasks smoothly. Courses may include tighter turns, rollbacks, trot fences, bending lines, or jumps taken off a shorter approach

Hunter Undersaddle:

Horses are shown on the flat at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. The class is judged on quality of movement and overall performance.

Extra Ride (Hors Concours): \$30.00

If riders wish to attempt the course again, they may pay a \$30 Extra Ride fee and re-ride the course Hors Concours.

Points will be given for the Hunter O/F, Handy Hunter O/F, and Hunter U/S to determine the division champion.

Oxers will be added to the course at 2'6", and combinations may be added at 2'9".

Specialty Hunter Classes



Country Lane Farms Hunt Seat Medal - \$45 Entry Fee

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a hunter course with 8 or more obstacles at heights of 2'3", 2'6" 2'9", and 3'0". Ride off is included in the course. Finals will be held at the Country Lane Classic, July 11-13. To qualify for finals, riders must have placed (8th place or higher) in at least 1 CLF Hunt Seat Medal class. Each offered height will run with classes of that height.

Hunter Derby - \$60 Entry Fee

Open to all horses and riders. One round format. To be judged as a handy round with unique turns and approaches, inside turns, slices, athleticism, boldness and impressive start and finish. High options will also be placed on course. Scores will be given for base score out of 100, plus 2 points for each high option jumped, and 10 total handy points available. High options will be 3 inches higher than the height set. Heights include 2'3, 2'6, 2'9, 3'0", and 3'3". Each offered height will run with classes of that height. Points accumulated throughout the series with an award given to the horse and rider combination with the most points at the SRC Spring Classic Show.



Jumper Classes



Jumper Divisions \$90/Division

Child/Junior divisions open to riders 17 and under. Adult Amateur divisions open to riders 18 and older who are amateur riders Open divisions open to all horses and riders. Year end points awarded to Juniors and Amateurs only. Divisions may be combined at managements discretion. Each Jumper Division under 0.90m consists of a combination of 2 optimum time classes and 1 immediate jump off class. Each Jumper Division 0.90m and over consists of 1 optimum time class, 1 speed class and 1 immediate jump off class.

Speed (0.90m & Above):

Class consists of up to 10 jumps. To be judged as a speed round with rails down adding 7 seconds on to the horse and riders time score. A time allowed will be posted with 1 time fault given for every 2 seconds over the time allowed.

Optimum Time:

To consist of 1 round of up to 12 jumps. An optimum time which is 4 seconds less than the time allowed will be posted on the course, and rounds will be placed such that the the nearest time to the optimum with the least faults will win the class. Faults to be calculated based on Table A.

Immediate Jump Off:

Round 1 to consist of up to 10 jumps. A time allowed will be posted with a time fault given for every 2 seconds over the time allowed. 4 faults given to every rail down or refusal. Horses and riders that are clear in round 1 advance to the jump off. The fastest time with the least faults wins the class.

Extra Ride (Hors Concours): \$30.00

If riders wish to attempt the course again, they may pay a \$30 Extra Ride fee and re-ride the course Hors Concours.

Points will be given for the Optimum Time Round and the Immediate Jump Off Round to determine the division champion.

Specialty Jumper Classes



SRC Mini Prix - \$60 Entry Fee

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged over a jumper course with 8 or more obstacles in round 1 with an immediate jump off for riders with a clear first round. Heights offered are 0.75m, 0.85m, 0.90m, and 1.00m. A time allowed will be posted with a time fault given for every 2 seconds over the time allowed. 4 faults given to every rail down or refusal. Horses and riders that are clear in round 1 advance to the jump off. The fastest time with the least faults wins the class. Points accumulated throughout the series with an award given to the horse and rider combination with the most points at the SRC Spring Classic Show. Each offered height will run with classes of that height.

In-Hand Classes



Open Halter Class All Breed, All Ages (In-Hand)

An all-breed halter class judges horses on their overall conformation, quality, and presence, regardless of breed. Horses are shown in-hand at the walk and trot and evaluated on structure, balance, movement, and overall condition. This class highlights the horse's natural quality and suitability as a performance or breeding prospect. The handler is not judged.

Class #350

Open Showmanship at Halter (In-Hand)

A class judged on the handler's ability to present a well-turned-out horse in-hand. Exhibitors must complete a designated pattern demonstrating leading, setting up, turning, and overall presentation. The horse is judged on manners, grooming, and condition only; conformation is not considered. This class focuses on precision, control, and professional presentation by the handler.

Show Rules



General

All horses must have a number.

All riders must have their Horse Council of BC and have signed a waiver prior to receiving their number.

Lunging may take place in the lunge ring any time, and in the indoor arena before 7:00am

Class Add

Classes may be entered at any time with no additional charge

Refunds

Stall reservation refunds will be given up to 72 hours prior to the start of the show. Stall cancellations after that time will only be refunded if your stall is filled. All other refunds will be given at anytime.

Tack

No tack restrictions in classes. Hunter tack recommended for hunter, hunter derby, and equitation classes.

Attire

All riders must wear a number. ASTMapproved helmets and appropriate footwear must be worn. Braiding and show jackets are optional.

Show Office

The show office will be open 1 hour prior to the start of each show on show days. All competitors are to check out at the show office once finished their classes for the show to settle their account.

Vaccines

All horse must be vaccinated within 6 months of attending shows.

Smoking

There is no smoking on the property.

Dogs

Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up after your dog.

Concession

A concession will be available 30 minutes prior to the start of the show until the end of the last class. Cash or card only.

Dangerous Conduct or Horse Abuse

Management reserves the right to excuse a competitor for horse abuse of dangerous conduct on or off their horse.

Show Entry Closing Dates

5:00pm on warm up day of each show. Please email management if you wish to enter after the closing date.

Loading and Unloading Horses

All horses must be loaded and unloaded in the area between the indoor arena and covered lunge ring. Trailers are not to drive into the stabling area.


