to Stewart Equine Enterprises' SpringFest 2026. The year of the horse is here and we couldn't be more proud to celebrate by horse showing with you!

New this year are two Stewart Equine specific divisions. These are Jumping Seat Equitation divisions to be run at 2'9" and 3'. Throughout the year, those Equitation riders who earn 80 points will receive a medal and be highlighted on the Stewart Equine Facebook page.

Specs can be found after the OHJA Medal specs below as well as here;

These classes shall be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgement, and execution of an efficient, time saving pace and track.

Two refusals shall constitute elimination and four points will be deducted for each knockdown.

While no time will be recorded - any round that is either grossly too slow or is dangerously too fast will be penalized.

All USEF legal jumper equipment is allowed.

Points as followed: 1st - 10; 2nd - 6; 3rd - 4; 4th - 2; 5th - 1; 6th - 0.5. An extra 5 points will be given to the champion. In the event of a tie for champion, the first class will be the tie breaker. Riders who amass 80 points during the year will receive a medal and enjoy a Facebook post for recognition.

General Information

Schooling Rated Recognized by HJEO and OHJA

Reserve stalls with Courtney. Entries will be limited to the first 75 horses. Best efforts will be made to fill stalls of those who cancel after making a reservation. Management reserves the right to treat anyone who reserves a stall and does not show up as a non-showing horse in the event we cannot fill your spot. Note - cancellations the week of are very rarely filled.

No shows are anyone who reserves a stall and does not show up. They will be billed a \$250 cancellation fee instead of their stall and non-showing fees.

Stall Payment must be received one month prior to the start of the show. If payment is not received management reserves the right to give your stall away to someone on the waitlist. All stalls are \$125.

WaitList - stalls will be available to those on the waitlist starting one month prior to the start of the show.

Start time - 8 a.m. both Saturday and Sunday (Management reserves the right to alter these at any time.)

Friday open schooling - noon to 6 p.m. **2' and 18" only from 5:30 to 6 p.m..** Those riders are welcome to school and prepare earlier as well. Additional 2' and 18" schooling - Saturday and Sunday at 7:30 a.m.

Entry desk is open on Friday from noon to 6 p.m.

Entries received after 5 p.m. Friday will be charged a \$50 late fee.

Entries can be emailed, mailed, or submitted online at see.horsespot.net (online entries will close at 5 p.m. on Friday).

Show requirements: Appropriate attire - i.e. shirts with a collar, properly fitting breeches, and an ASTM approved helmet. Negative Coggins, Health Certificates for out of state exhibitors, and recent vaccine records.

Ribbons are awarded for first through sixth place.

Stalls are \$125 for the weekend.

Valid forms of payment: Check to "Stewart Equine Enterprises" or credit card or venmo (Courtney-Stewart-126).

Non-showing horses must enter and pay a \$60 showing fee in lieu of a division or class fee.

A \$60 Administration/Management fee plus **\$30 medic** fee will be charged to every horse/ rider combination.

No "haul-ins" are allowed.

Horse Welfare - The management and horse show officials reserve the right to limit showing and schooling if it is believed to be in the best interest of the horse.

Showing not to be judged: if time permits is available at management's discretion. In all cases, once an animal has appeared on a card "not to be judged" it is no longer eligible to be judged on that card thereafter with any entry number.

Refunds - no refunds will be given, please check your bill carefully. Early stall checks can be returned with a vet scratch.

Returned checks - will be subject to a \$45 handling fee

Hunter Classics

\$300 Grassroots Hunter Classic - \$40 to enter. 12 must enter to fill.

Class will run concurrently with all hunter divisions 2' and 18". To be scored over 2 rounds - Hunter 2 from Saturday and Hunter 3 from Sunday to count. Open scoring.

Riders in multiple divisions on the same horse must declare which division will count prior to showing.

Horses with multiple riders may be on the card once per rider.

Prize money as follows: 1st - \$140, 2nd - \$100, 3rd - \$30, 4th - \$30

\$500 Open Hunter Classic - \$60 to enter. 12 must enter to fill.

Class will run concurrently with all hunter divisions 2'3" and higher. To be scored over 2 rounds - Hunter 2 from Saturday and Hunter 3 from Sunday to count. Open scoring.

Riders in multiple divisions on the same horse must declare which division will count prior to showing.

Horses with multiple riders may be on the card once per rider.

Prize money as follows: 1st - \$250, 2nd - \$150, 3rd - \$50, 4th - \$5

Circuit Awards

\$300 Stewart Equine High Point Hunter Award - to be awarded to the horse/rider combination that has the most points from a single hunter division across all four Claremore shows in 2023. The division does not need to be the same from show to show. Ties will split the prize money.

\$750 Stewart Equine Trainer Bonus - \$400 to be awarded to the trainer with the most points from their top 2 horse/ rider combinations' best hunter or jumper division across all four Claremore shows in 2023. \$350 to be awarded to the second place trainer.

HJEO Schooling division specifications as of February 2020

Short Stirrup Hunter and Equitation (18")

Open to non-pro riders, age ten and under that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian shows
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/Long Stirrup hunter or equitation

Trotting not to be penalized. Canterng prohibited in under saddle and Flat classes. To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization. No boxes, fill, or oxers.

Long Stirrup Hunter and Equitation (18")

Open to non-pro riders, age 11 and over that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian shows
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/ Long Stirrup hunter or equitation

Trotting not to be penalized. Canterng is prohibited in under saddle and flat classes. To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization. No boxes, fill, or oxers.

Academy Short/Long Stirrup Hunter and Equitation (18")

Open to non-pro riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian shows
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Short Stirrup or Academy Short/ Long Stirrup hunter or equitation
- Are showing on an academy horse (as described in the HJEO constitution section 13)

Trotting not to be penalized. Canterng prohibited in under saddle and Flat classes. To be judged on manner of going, jumping style, correct pace, and organization. No boxes, fill, or oxers.

Open 2' Hunter And Equitation (2')

Hunter classes open to professional and non-professional riders. Trotting lead changes is not to be penalized. Canterng is prohibited in under saddle classes.

Equitation classes open only to non professional riders who have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA or USEF recognized shows.

This is an open division created for green horses and/or green riders not yet ready to move up to the 2'3" height.

To be judged on manner of going, jumping style and suitability for the beginner hunter ring. Because this is an open division, correct leads and a consistent number of strides may be considered, but simple lead changes are not to be penalized. No boxes, fill or oxers

2'3" Very Low Hunter (2'3")

Open to all riders of any age. Fill, no oxers.

Beginner Hunter And Equitation (2'3")

Open to non-professional riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'9" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian recognized shows.

- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in beginner or academy beginner hunter or equitation divisions.

This should be judged like all other hunter divisions, except that special consideration must be given to older, shorter-strided horses who can no longer do the step comfortably. On these types of horses, the add step may be acceptable at judge's discretion. Flying changes are expected. No oxers.

Academy Beginner Hunter And Equitation (2'3")

Open to non-professional riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 2'6" or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian recognized shows.
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in beginner or academy beginner hunter or equitation divisions.
- Are showing on an academy horse (as described in HJEO constitution section 13

Trotting lead changes is not to be penalized.

Same specs as Beginner, except that simple changes are not to be penalized. This division was created for school horses, so that they may compete against each other on a more level playing field.

In the event that the beginner and academy beginner are combined, the judge will be informed which horses qualify as academy horses, and those horses will be judged accordingly and will not be penalized for simple changes. No oxers.

2'6" open hunter (2'6")

Open to all riders of any age.

Intermediate Hunter And Equitation (2'6")

Open to non-professional riders that:

- Have not competed in any classes with fences 3' or higher at any HJEO, OHJA, or US Equestrian recognized shows.
- Have not been awarded a champion or reserve champion year end award by HJEO in Intermediate hunter or equitation divisions.

T.I.P. Special Thoroughbred Hunters (2'6")

Eligible horses must provide T.I.P. Numbers to the event organizer with entry. For more information, visit www.tjctip.com. Must present proof of registration when checking in. Shall consist of three classes—two over fences and one under saddle. Jump courses should consist of at least seven jumps, to be judged on manners, pace and way of going unless otherwise noted. Under saddle class to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions, and to be judged on manners, movement and way of going. Ribbons for first through sixth place for each class and Champion/ Reserve ribbons will be provided. T.I.P. Championships Qualifying division.

Modified Children's/Adult Hunter And Equitation (2'9")

Open to non-professional riders.

Ch/Ad Equitation (3')

Open to all riders of any age. Equitation Non-Pro Only.

HJEO Mini Medal

To be shown over a figure-eight course with fences to 2'6". Only equitation counts. The rider must be an HJEO member. This class is designed for beginner and intermediate riders. The winners shall be qualified for the annual ride-off.

Three exhibitors must be entered and show for the class to count.

Must be a member of the corresponding organization to enter.

OHJA Classes

OHJA 3' Medal

Open to OHJA Junior and amateur members only. At least three riders must complete the course, which consists of eight jumps with two changes of direction. Fences 3'. Additional tests (tests 1-14) of the top two to six riders are required.

OHJA Beginner Medal

Open to riders who are current OHJA members. Refer to OHJA CAP manual page 11 (part II, number 5).

Stewart Equine Divisions

2'9" Jumping Seat Equitation Silver Medal Division

Fences set at 2'9".

These classes shall be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgement, and execution of an efficient, time saving pace and track.

Two refusals shall constitute elimination and four points will be deducted for each knockdown.

While no time will be recorded - any round that is either grossly too slow or is dangerously too fast will be penalized.

All legal USEF jumper equipment is allowed.

Points as followed: 1st - 10; 2nd - 6; 3rd - 4; 4th - 2; 5th - 1; 6th - 0.5. An extra 5 points will be given to the champion. In the event of a tie for champion, the first class will be the tie breaker. Riders who amass 80 points during the year will receive a medal and enjoy a Facebook post for recognition.

3' Jumping Seat Equitation Gold Medal Division

Fences set at 3'.

These classes shall be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgement, and execution of an efficient, time saving pace and track.

Two refusals shall constitute elimination and four points will be deducted for each knockdown.

While no time will be recorded - any round that is either grossly too slow or is dangerously too fast will be penalized.

All legal USEF jumper equipment is allowed.

Points as followed: 1st - 10; 2nd - 6; 3rd - 4; 4th - 2; 5th - 1; 6th - 0.5. An extra 5 points will be given to the champion.
