Open to riders of all ages. Adults may ride ponies. Fences up to 18 inches. Trotting and simple changes are permitted. To be judged on suitability, manners, performance and soundness.

Open to riders of all ages. Adults may ride ponies. Fences up to 2 feet. Simple changes permitted. To be judged on suitability, manners, performance and soundness.

Outreach Equitation**\$20 per class**

Open to Junior and Amateur riders. To be judged on hands, seat, leg and control of mount. In the flat class, riders may be tested with equitation-related tests including, but not limited to, sitting trot, two-point, and change of direction at the trot. Riders may choose their height (2', 2'3", 2'6" or 3"). Will run open card with the hunter classes.

Open to riders of all ages. Riders may not cross enter into any divisions that include cantering or jumping. Riders may be asked questions by the judge or asked to 2-point or drop their reins and pick them up correctly.

Mini-Stirrup Walk/Trot Equitation OR**\$20 per class**

Open to riders of all ages. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any divisions that include cantering. To be judged on the rider's seat, legs, hands, posture, and control of mount.

Horse/Pony will be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into any divisions that include cantering.

Pleasure Horse/Pony**\$20 per class**

To be judged on suitability, manners, performance, soundness and how "pleasurable" the ride appears. Adults may ride ponies. Horses may be asked to extend the trot, halt and back up. Riders may not cross into jumping classes higher than 2'.

Short Stirrup Equitation OR**\$20 per class**

Open to riders age 13 or under. Judged on manners, equitation and suitability of mount to rider (50% on rider, 50% on mount). Riders may not cross into divisions jumping 2 ft or higher.

Long Stirrup Equitation OR**\$20 per class**

Open to riders age 14 and over. Judged on manners, equitation and suitability of mount to rider (50% on rider, 50% on mount). Riders may not cross into divisions jumping 2' or higher. Will combine with Short Stirrup if entries do not warrant divisions being split.

18" Crossrail Hunter OR**\$20 per class**

Open to riders of all ages. Trotting is permitted, horse/rider combination may not cross into any other jumping classes jumping higher than crossrails. Adults may ride ponies. Simple changes permitted. To be judged on suitability, manners, performance and soundness.

Show Rules and Information

Entries	Pre-entry is required to attend these events using HorseSpot.net . All entries must be received at least 48 hours prior to show date. Payment is due the day of the show (except to reserve overnight stalls). Scratches for refund must be done before the class begins. Entrants must sign a release of liability before showing. Riders under 18 must have a parent or legal guardian signature. For show purposes, rider's age is as of 12/1/2025.
Horses	Negative Coggins required within one year. Any stallions on show premises must be handled/ridden by persons 21 years of age or older. Show management reserves the right to excuse stallions from any class due to poor behavior. Dangerous or unsportsmanlike conduct in the arena, during breaks, or while competing, and/or lack of soundness or condition is cause for dismissal from the class or show at the discretion of the judge and/or the show management.
Stalls	Limited day and overnight stalls are available. Overnight stalls must be paid in full before the show and an estimated time of arrival must be given to show staff. No refunds will be given for overnight stalls after reservation. Venmo (preferred) or checks payable to "Robinson Equestrian" are accepted for stall reservations. Overnight stalls include schooling the night before.
Show Office	Show office opens at 7:30 am and remains open for 30 minutes after the show. Payment is due prior to riding. Payment methods are credit card (3.5% fee will be added), Venmo (@Robinson-Equestrian), check made payable to "Robinson Equestrian," and cash.
Schooling	The arena will be open for schooling 7:30-8:30 am and other designated schooling breaks. Haul-ins the evening before may school from 3:00-7:00 pm.
Prizes / Points	<p>Ribbons to 6th place. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded to all hunter/ equitation divisions with 3 or more riders. Ties are broken by points over fences or by most difficult class. Ribbons can be picked up at the show office.</p> <p>Points are awarded for these events for the CPJHSA Local Series. Provide your CPJHSA number if you would like your points to count. Both horse and rider must be registered with CPJHSA.</p> <p>Riders must be a USHJA member at the free Outreach level (or higher) in order to earn points. Please provide the show office with your USHJA ID number when entering. Horses are not required to be registered or microchipped to compete. If owners wish for their horse to earn points toward year-end awards, the horse must be registered with USHJA. Outreach classes are denoted on the prize list with an "OR" or "Outreach" in the division name.</p>
Attire	ASTM/SEI-approved helmets and proper footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. Jackets are not required. Polos and nice looking half chaps are acceptable. Traditional hunter/equitation tack is required. Martingales are prohibited in all flat classes.
Class Information	All fence heights are approximate. Show management reserves the right to cancel, split, or combine any class/division the day of the show.
Pets	No dogs on show grounds.
Concessions	Light concessions will be available (sandwiches, snacks, drinks)
