Continue on US-41 S for approximately 8 miles into Morriston

Turn left onto SE 55th St / SE 210th Ave (follow signage toward local farms)

Proceed about 1.8 miles, then turn right onto SE 212th Court

Diasti Stables will be on your left at 5350 SE 212th Court (watch for farm
signage)

Head toward Morriston, FL on US-41 S (if coming from the north) or on US-41 N (if
coming from the south)

Once in the Morriston area, turn east onto SE 55th St / SE 210th Ave
(this is a bit south of the center of Morriston; local signage will help) Continue about 1.8

Turn right onto SE 212th Court

Diasti Stables will be on your left at 5350 SE 212th Court

Note: US-41 runs along the west side of Morriston, so this turn will be clearly visible as
you approach the center of town. Diasti Stables is just 10 minutes from HITS and 20
minutes from World Equestrian Center (WEC), so these directions also work well if you're
coming from either show venue directionally.

Rules, Specifications, and General Information

This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the USEF. The official Federation rulebook will prevail for this show. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of these rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. Questions that may arise that are not covered by the USEF rulebook will be decided by the Show Committee and their decisions will be final.

Biosecurity:

- Health Certificate (14 days) – Required for all horses arriving from in the state and outside the state of Florida. The Health Certificate must be issued by a licensed Veterinarian and be dated within 14 days of check in, affirming that the horses entering the facility have not had an elevated temperature, been to a facility where there has been a positive or suspected positive case of EHV, been in a close proximity to an ill horse and receive routine vet care and vaccinations. The Health Certificate must be signed by a licensed veterinarian and on the vet's letterhead.
- Trainer/Owner Health Declaration – Signed by an owner/trainer confirming that the horse has not experienced a fever exceeding 101.5 degrees or any disease in the 72 hours leading up to its arrival. Additionally, the horse must not have been exposed to or treated for an unexplained fever in the past 28 days and should have tested negative for any disease at least 30 days prior to arrival. If the horse has tested positive within the last six months for any infectious diseases, this information should also be disclosed.
- Negative Coggins (12 months) – Proof of a current negative Coggins test within 12 months.
- Vaccinations (six months) – It is required all horses be vaccinated for Equine-EHV I/IV (either modified live or killed vaccine), Equine Influenza no sooner than seven days prior to and no later than 180 days (six months) prior to entering the show grounds. Most EHV-1 vaccines are only considered effective for 180 days. Please check with your veterinarian about which vaccine is right for your horse. We strongly recommend vaccinations against WNV, EEE, WEE, Tetanus and Rabies.
- All health documents can be uploaded to Horsespot.net. If hard copies are being presented, they must be given to the Show Secretary prior to unloading horses or ponies.

Competition Arena:

All weather sand & fiber footing 200' x 300'

Schooling Arena: 150' x 300'

Horses must be longed in the official longing area located behind Chestnut/Laurel Barns

Entry Deadlines:

Post entry fees will be charged if entries are not received on Horsespot.net by the previous Sunday each week.

ADDS/SCRATCHES:

All adds and scratches must be completed through the Show Office and taken to the ring PRIOR to the start of the added or scratched class.

Show Office Hours:

The Horse Show Office will be open beginning one hour before the start of each show day and will close one half hour after the last class commences.

Anyone mounted must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while on the show grounds (See GR 801.2)

Schooling:

Ticketed schooling will be available Monday afternoon from noon until

5:00pm @ \$20.00 per ticket. Complimentary schooling will be available the morning of the show from 6:00am until 7:15am to

prepare arena. We will also be running an hour schooling break at the conclusion of the Thoroughbred Section for Juniors and Amateurs to prepare.

Stabling:

Stabling is available for overnight (\$130.00) and day rentals (\$75.00).

11 x 10 DRY STALLS available with doors on a first come/first serve basis in a permanent building with rubber matted flooring. No initial shavings will be provided. Payment for stalls must accompany all stall reservations and will be non-refundable. Management reserves the right to limit tack stalls.

Hay and Bedding can be requested and paid for on diasti.horsespot.net or in the show office.

All dogs MUST be on a leash

Food concessions will be available during horse show hours.

USEF Motorized Vehicle Statement

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"): RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time. USEF Membership Statement

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

Hunter sections may be run as back-to-back classes at management's discretion. When classes are run back-to-back, exhibitors may perform both rounds before leaving the ring.

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as:

brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, panels. All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.

Horses will not be jogged for soundness unless otherwise noted.

Judges will reflect any unsoundness in their scores.

All Hunter Championships Classes: Awarded to the top two of the top four horses/ponies, which have earned the most points in over fences classes.

Jumping Order: Jumping order will be established in accordance with the USEF rules.

In all classes over obstacles, all horses being considered for an award must jog for soundness using either Option A or Option B below. Management must state in the competition prize list which method of jogging will be used. Horses/ponies that are unsound will be eliminated and ineligible for an award in that class. The judge's decision regarding soundness is final.

Option A: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fenced performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

Option B: Horses/ponies will be jogged together with the rider unmounted in the judge's order of preference. Two additional entries in addition to the number of ribbons must jog if there are sufficient entries. Horses/ponies may be asked to re-jog at the judge's discretion.

A horse/pony may not leave the ring until the job has been declared official by the judge, or it will be eliminated. A horse that is unruly, one that breaks away from the handler or one whose actions threaten to endanger the rider, handler, other exhibitors or their entries will be eliminated. (Exception: Hunter Breeding and Pony Breeding). A horse may not be eliminated for receiving outside assistance in the jog. In classes restricted to ponies a junior must jog the pony for soundness.

HU103 - All horses competing in the Federation licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed must be properly identified in accordance with GR 1101, and must also be registered with USHJA (see GR1101.1). The USEF/USHJA registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

Applications for USHJA Registration can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the USEF Horse

Registration application form. This form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, as a download from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management.

Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement in their prize list.

In addition to the provision of HU 101.1, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered. A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.


