2025 GHJA Rule Updates

UPDATED GENERAL INFORMATION

Electrical/Fire Regulations:

All electrical installations and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. Cooking is not permitted within the stable area. No Class I flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Any equipment using any kind of flame is strictly forbidden in the stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

UPDATED CLASS SCHEDULE

JUMPER DIVISION UPDATES

.90m (2'11") Junior/Amateur Jumper (Previously Low Junior/Amateur Jumper)

Fence height increased from .85m to .90m

Cross-entry limit increased to 1.00m

1.00m (3'3") Junior/Amateur Jumper (Previously High Junior/Amateur Jumper)

Fence height increased from .95m to 1.00m

Cross-entry limit increased to 1.10m

No restrictions on cross-entry between .90m and 1.00m Junior/Amateur Jumper classes.

All .85m and .95m jumper classes have been removed per GHJA guidelines.

EQUITATION UPDATES

11 & Under, 12-14, and 15-17 Equitation eligibility updated to December 1, 2024.

HUNTER DIVISION UPDATES

Adult Amateur Hunter: The following rule has been removed:

"A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur Hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Equitation classes or Junior Medals at the same show."

GHJA Specifications

- Sims Equestrian Management Services LLC dbaCheryl & Co., their employees and officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons, horses or to any property while attending the shows, nor will they be responsible for any personal article which may be lost, stolen or destroyed.
- Schooling is only permitted in the show rings at specified times. Warm-up rings are available; horses may not be turned loose in the rings. A \$100.00 fine will be levied for any unauthorized schooling over show fences.
- Sims Equestrian Management Services LLC dbaCheryl & Co. Local Member Show of the Georgia Hunter Jumper Association, Inc. and is operated in accordance with the current rules of GHJA. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for a knowledge of, and is subject to the rules of the GHJA. Members receive or have access to a copy of the current rule book of the GHJA at www.ghja.org. No points will count toward Annual Awards before membership dues have been paid and horse is registered with the GHJA.
- Proper attire is required in all classes; formal attire and braiding are encouraged in Derby and Final's classes.
- Protective A.S.T.M./S.E.I approved Headgear is mandatory at all times when mounted. Chin straps must be snug.
- Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
- Horses and ponies may enter no more than seven "over fences" classes, no more than five of which can be Jumper classes, on a single show day. All warm-up trips and special classes, such as equitation medals, hunter classics, derbies, and stakes classes are included in this total. All Jumper classics, stakes, warm-ups, and clear round classes shall count towards the limit of five Jumper classes.
- Questions not covered by GHJA rules will be decided by the horse show management; such decision shall be final.
- Minor exhibitors—Parents or guardians shall hold the management, staff, and facility of the horse show harmless for any injury to such minor. A minor's entry will only be accepted when it is signed by a parent or guardian.
- Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate motorized vehicles of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show.
- The courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory dotted line which will be indicated on the course diagram.
- In classes with a posted order of go, the 1 minute rule will be in effect. The 3 minute rule will be in effect for all other classes.
- Flat classes will not be delayed for trainer conflict. A ring will not be held more than 5 minutes for a conflict between 2 over-fences classes.

 Gatekeepers are authorized to drop late riders to the end of the jumping order or to scratch riders who do not enter a ring in a timely manner, with no refund to exhibitors. Please plan classes accordingly and notify the gatekeepers of legitimate ring conflicts between over-fences classes so that a compatible order can be established. It is recommended that trainers have an assistant available if a conflict is anticipated.
- Proof of a current negative Coggins test is required to bring horses onto the horse show grounds.
- Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy toward a Judge, Show Official, stall or crew member, or a Will's Park employee on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member, or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry, and all fees will be forfeited
- Correct back numbers must be worn in all classes or the horse/rider may not receive a score; numbers must be worn to enter any ring for warm-up.
- Points cannot be counted for classes completed by fewer than three horses. Related divisions may be combined when entries in one are fewer than six.
- Poling and offsets are absolutely forbidden anywhere on the show grounds.
- All dogs must be on a leash, or otherwise securely contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Said leash must be no more than 6 feet in length, and must be held in hand or secured to an immobile fixture. Retractable leashes must be locked at a length of 6 feet or less. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment by the horse show or by the local government. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines under GHJA Rules 18 and 19. Warning cards may be issued to such dog owners, an accumulation of which shall result in further penalties
- Limited Entries: For the betterment of the show, entries may be closed and/or classes may be limited in number. Please enter early and completely.
- Entry Deadline: Enter online, by fax or by mail postmarked by Tuesday prior to horse show. Only entries submitted online, by mail or fax on an official entry blank will be accepted. Stalls will be reserved only with completed entry blanks. No entries or stall reservations will be accepted by telephone.
- Entries to: www.TheCo.HorseSpot.net
- Late Entries: All entries received after Wednesday will be accepted for classes that have not been closed. A Late Fee of \$20.00 per entry will be charged. Late entries must be submitted on the official entry form. Incomplete or illegible entries, or entries not printed on the entry form will be returned to the entrant and designated as late.
- Add/Scratch: Adds and scratches must be made in the show office and Add/Scratch slips must be presented to the gatekeepers to enter a ring if your name is not on the class list. Scratch tickets are mandatory to remove a class from your show bill.
- Measurements: GHJA or USEF pony measurement cards must be presented at check in in order to receive back numbers.
- GHJA Membership Numbers: In order for points to count toward year-end awards, entry forms must include the horse, owner and rider's GHJA Membership Number.
- Non-members are welcome to show in all classes except the GHJA Medal classes and the GHJA Equitation Challenge.
- All Horses on the Show Grounds: All horses whether showing or not must complete an entry form, pay office and other applicable fees, and riders, when mounted, and must wear their assigned back number at all times.
- Bedding: At least 3 bags are required in all stalls, whether occupied for a day or for the weekend. Initial shavings ordered will be at your stall upon your arrival on Thursday. Additional shavings may be ordered in the office and will be delivered between 8:30-3:00. For same day delivery orders must be place in show office no later than 1:30 p.m. No shavings will be delivered on Sunday.
- Champion and Reserve Ribbons will be award in each hunter division, as well as ribbons for 1st through 6th place in each class. Age Group Equitation classes will be pinned to 6th place; no championship will be awarded, although a sponsored prize may be presented to a high-point rider. See class specs for details of jumper and special classes' pinning and awards.
- The class schedule may be changed for the betterment of the show; Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge, should a legitimate need arise.

GHJA Class Specifications 2025

<u>Hunter Over Fences</u> To be shown over at least eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.

<u>Hunter Under Saddle</u> To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Martingales not permitted.

<u>Courses</u> Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop and panels.

All hunter divisions will be held in accordance with GHJA rules. Hunter Divisions with less than 3 entries may be combined. Pony must possess and present to the office a GHJA or USEF measurement card to compete in any Pony Hunter division. Thoroughbred Hunter classes require proof of pedigree; TIP membership is acceptable.

Horses and ponies may enter no more than seven "over fences" classes, no more than five of which can be Jumper classes, on a single show day. All warm-up trips and special classes, such as equitation medals, hunter classics, derbies, and stakes classes are included in this total. All Jumper classics, stakes, warm-ups, and clear round classes shall count towards the limit of five Jumper classes.

Equitation Classes

Short Stirrup Equitation Open to qualified Short Stirrup rider. Fence height 2'.

Long Stirrup Equitation Open to qualified Long Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'3".

Equitation 11 & Under Open to Juniors whose 12th birthday is not before December 1, 20**24**. Fence height 2'. No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

Equitation 12-14 Open to Juniors whose 15th birthday is not before December 1, 20**24**. Fence height 2'6". No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

Equitation 15-17 Open to Juniors whose 18th birthday is not before December 1, 20**24**. Fence height 3'

Adult Equitation Open to Adult Amateurs. Fence height 3'

Jumper Classes

<u>.80 m (2'7") Jumper</u> Open to all riders on horses or ponies. <u>.90 m (2'11") Jumper</u> Open to all riders on horses or ponies

<u>.90 m (2'11") Jr./Amateur Jumper</u> Open to Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider combo may not cross-enter into classes higher than **1.0m** at the same horse show.

1.00 m (3'3") **Jumper** Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

1.00 m (3'3") Jr./Amateur Jumper Open to Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider combo may not cross-enter into classes higher than 1.10m (3'7") at the same horse show

1.10 m (3'7") **Jumper** Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

Medal Classes

Specifications for GHJA Medals Must be a GHJA Member to compete in the GHJA Medal classes. To be shown over a modified jumper-type course of at least 8 fences. The course must include at least one oxer and one change of direction. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the horse. A minimum of 6 riders, if available, will be required to show on the flat. The flat phase shall count for 25%. Judges may require riders to perform any USEF test 1-23. Management has the option of placing two tests from USEF 1-8 into the jumping phase in lieu of the 25% flat phase. Three entries must complete the over fences and testing requirements for qualification points to count.

GHJA Pony Medal

Ponies with measurement cards to be ridden by Junior riders. Small ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 12 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'. Medium ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 14 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'3". Large ponies to be ridden by Juniors to be jumped at 2'6".

J.D. Pounds Junior Medal

Open to Juniors on horses. Fence height 3'.

GHJA Adult Medal

Open to Adult Amateurs on horses or ponies. Fence height 3'. Ponies may not be shown by a junior in any other classes

GHJA Medals can be combined if there are less than three in any of the three medals. However, rider/horse must jump at appropriate fence height.

GHJA Equitation Challenge Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur GHJA members on horses or ponies. To be judged at a walk, trot, and canter. Competitors will be asked to perform at least two of the following USEF tests chosen by the Judge: #2- Halt (4 to 6 seconds) or Halt and Back; #10- Change leads on a line demonstrating a simple or flying change of lead; #13-Ride without stirrups; #15- Canter on the counter lead (Note: no more than twelve horses may counter canter at one time); #19- Perform basic dressage movements. Judges may choose from shoulder in, shoulder out, haunches in, haunches out, leg yield, and half pass; #20- Hand gallop. Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated. Riders who have won the final GHJA Equitation Challenge in the previous three years are no longer eligible to compete in this class. November 1st is the cut-off date for riding in qualifying classes at shows.

See GHJA rule book Appendix B for tests' details.

Hunter Classes

<u>Silver Stirrup Hunter</u>: Open to adult amateur riders, 35 years of age and older, who have not shown in classes with fence heights 2'6" or higher in the past three (3) years. **Fence height 2'**, no oxers.

<u>Pre-Children's Hunter:</u> Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider com-bination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". Horse rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into children's hunter.

<u>Pre-Adult Hunter:</u> Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". Horse Rider Combo MAY NOT cross enter into Adult hunter.

<u>Children's Hunter:</u> Open to all horses ridden by a Junior. Fence height 3'. Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Pre Children's Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies Fence height 3'. Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Pre-Adult Hunter.

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to any registered Thoroughbred, ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professional riders. Fence height 2'6 or 2'9 at the discretion of show management. Non-registered thoroughbred horses may apply for approved eligibility by submitting reliable proof of pedigree to GHJA.

<u>Green Hunter</u>: 2'3" or 2'6" at the discretion of show management. Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 2' at any show. A horse or pony's eligibility is limited to two consecutive show years during which time the horse or pony may not show in any division with fences higher than 2'6" or it will lose its Green status. Open to all riders.

Modified Hunter: Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9".

Open Hunter: Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'6" or 3'. Rider may show at either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.

<u>Performance Hunter</u>: Open to all riders on horses. Fence height 3'3"/3'6".

Schooling Pony: Open to Junior riders only on ponies. Fence height 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainer's discretion.

Small Pony Hunter: Open to Junior riders 12 years of age or under on ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh. Fence height 2'. **Medium Pony Hunter**: Open to Junior riders 14 years of age or under on ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh. Fence height 2'3".

<u>Large Pony Hunter</u>: Open to Junior riders on ponies not to exceed 14.2 hh. Fence height 2'6".

Hunter Classes

Short Stirrup Hunter: Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Fence height 2'. Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years, as defined by the show calendar year starting December 1st and ending November 30th. The two years of eligibility may not be separated or divided in any manner. Short and Long Stirrup eligibility are counted together when age eligibility overlaps during the two years: a rider may compete in Short and/or Long Stirrup Divisions for a total of two consecutive show years. Eligibility is determined by the rider, without regard to horse-rider combination.

The rider must adhere to the following parameters at all GHJA locally sanctioned and USEF recognized shows:

- (i) Short Stirrup eligible riders **may** enter or cross-enter into only hunter classes or divisions that are unrecognized by GHJA or USEF. Fence height not to exceed 2'3";
- (ii) Short Stirrup eligible riders **may** enter or cross-enter into age group equitation divisions that do not to exceed 2'6" in height;
- (iii) Short Stirrup eligible riders **may not** enter or cross-enter into GHJA or USEF recognized Medal classes;
- (iv) Short Stirrup eligible riders **may only** enter or cross-enter in Jumper classes at or below 0.65m.

See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification regarding eligibility (this is a brief version)

Long Stirrup Hunter: Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to Junior and Amateur riders ages 13 years and older on horses or ponies, in the rider's first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Fence height 2'3". Riders may show in Long Stirrup for two consecutive show years, as defined by the show calendar year starting December 1st and ending November 30th. The two years of eligibility may not be separated or divided in any manner. Short and Long Stirrup eligibility are counted together when age eligibility overlaps during the two years: a rider may compete in Short and/or Long Stirrup for a total of two consecutive years. Eligibility is determined by the rider, without regard to horse-rider combination.

The rider must adhere to the following parameters at all GHJA locally sanctioned and USEF recognized shows:

- (i) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may** enter or cross-enter into only hunter classes or divisions that are unrecognized by GHJA or USEF. Fence height not to exceed 2'6";
- (ii) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may** enter or cross-enter into age group equitation divisions that do not to exceed 2'6" in height;
- (iii) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may not** enter or cross-enter into GHJA or USEF recognized Medal classes;
- (iv) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may** only enter or cross-enter in Jumper classes at or below 0.70 m.

See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification regarding eligibility (this is a brief version)

Leadline

Rider must be in first year of showing and has not trotted or cantered on their own. May not cross into any other division (At the same show).

Pre-Beginner

Open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Walk/Halt Equitation (to be judged on rider), Walk/Trot Pleasure (to be judged on mount's suitability as a beginner mount not movement). Riders may only cross-enter into Beginner Groundrails.

Beginner Groundrails

Open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Groundrails Once Around Tracking Left, Groundrails Once Around Tracking Right, Groundrails Walk/Trot. Riders may cross-enter into EITHER the Pre-Beginner Flat Division.

Beginner Flat

Open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Walk/Trot Equitation (to be judged on rider), Walk/Trot Pleasure (to be judged on mount's suitability as a beginner mount not on movement), and Walk/Trot/Canter One at a Time (to be judged on rider). Riders may cross-enter into the Beginner Groundrails division OR the Beginner Crossrails division.

Beginner Crossrails

Open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Beginner Crossrails Once Around, Beginner Crossrails Twice Around and Beginner Crossrails Under Saddle (Walk/Trot/Canter). All classes will be judged on the rider's ability to navigate a course of crossrails and the mount's suitability as a beginner mount. Riders may trot and/or canter the crossrails. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into the Beginner Flat division OR the Mini-Stirrup division.

Mini Stirrup

Riders must be in their first two years of showing. All classes will be judged on the rider's ability to navigate a course of crossrails and the mount's suitability as a beginner mount. Lines are to be trotted in and cantered out. Riders may cross enter into Beginner Crossrails OR Crossrail Hunter (At the same show). U/S is Walk, Trot, Canter.

Crossrail Hunter

Open to horses in their first two years of showing and/or riders in their first two years of showing (not counting beginner years). Division will consist of two over fences classes and one under saddle class to be judged as hunter classes. Horses may trot and/or canter courses. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into Mini Stirrup OR Mini Hunter/Eq

Beginner Equitation Challenge

Equitation Flat class open to all beginner riders. Riders can be asked to Halt, Walk, Sit the Trot, Post the Trot, Canter, Reverse, 2-point, and/or answer a question from the judge.

Mini Equitation

Fence height 18" verticals/gates. Open to horses in their first two years of showing and/or riders in their first two years of showing (not counting beginner years). Division will consist of two over fences classes and one under saddle class to be judged as Equitation classes. Courses are Walk Trot Canter and simple lead changes will not be penalized.

Mini Hunter

Fence height 18" verticals/gates. Open to horses in their first two years of showing and/or riders in their first two years of showing (not counting beginner years). Division will consist of two over fences classes and one under saddle class to be judged as hunter classes. Horses may trot and/or canter courses. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into Crossrail Hunter.

Schooling Hunter

Open to all rider on horses or ponies. 2' with no oxers.

Pre-Child/Adult Equitation

Open to horse/rider combinations that are eligible to compete in pre-children's or pre-adult hunter. 2'6" Fence Height.

From I-75 North & South of Atlanta: Take I- 285 West to Exit 62 Spur 14 S. Fulton Pkwy, then below*.

From I-20 heading West: Take I-285 heading south to Exit 62 Spur 14 S. Fulton Pkwy, then below.*

From I-85 heading South: Take Exit 69 Spur 14 S. Fulton Pkwy From South Fulton Prkwy, then below.*

*For all directions above: Stay on S. Fulton Pkwy for 7.5 miles then Right on "Hwy 92 Campbellton Fairburn Rd". Go 4.5 miles then Left on "Cascade Palmetto Rd". Go 0.3 miles then Right on "Cochran Mill Rd". Go 1 and 1/4 mile, then right into show entrance.

From I-20 heading East: Take Exit 37 Hwy 92 Fairburn/ Douglasville; end of ramp go Right on 92 South/ Fairburn Rd. Go 5.2 miles then go Right at light staying on 92 South Fairburn Rd. Go for 4.2 miles then at light go Right on Cascade Palmetto Rd. Go 0.3 miles then Right on Cochran Mill Rd. Go 1/2 mile, then right onto Cedar Grove Road show entrance is 1 and 1/4 mile on the right. From I-85 heading North: Take Exit 61 Hwy 74, Fairburn; end of ramp go left heading North on 74. When the 4 lane turns into a 2 lane, stay straight (do not continue on 74; go straight for 2.3 miles until the road dead ends into Rivertown. Go left on Rivertown for 3.5 miles to S. Fulton

Footing: at Bouckaert Farm is all-weather • Ring sizes: Jumper - 200x300, Hunter Rings - 150x300 • Food Service: will be available every day • Lunging: will be allowed in the designated areas only. No lunging allowed in show or schooling rings. All horses must wear, or be accompanied with a visible entry number. No chasing, whip cracking, or plastic bags on whips. Stirrups may not hang from the saddle while longeing.

Dangerous horses will not be permitted and will be asked to leave. No phones or radios in schooling or performance rings.
